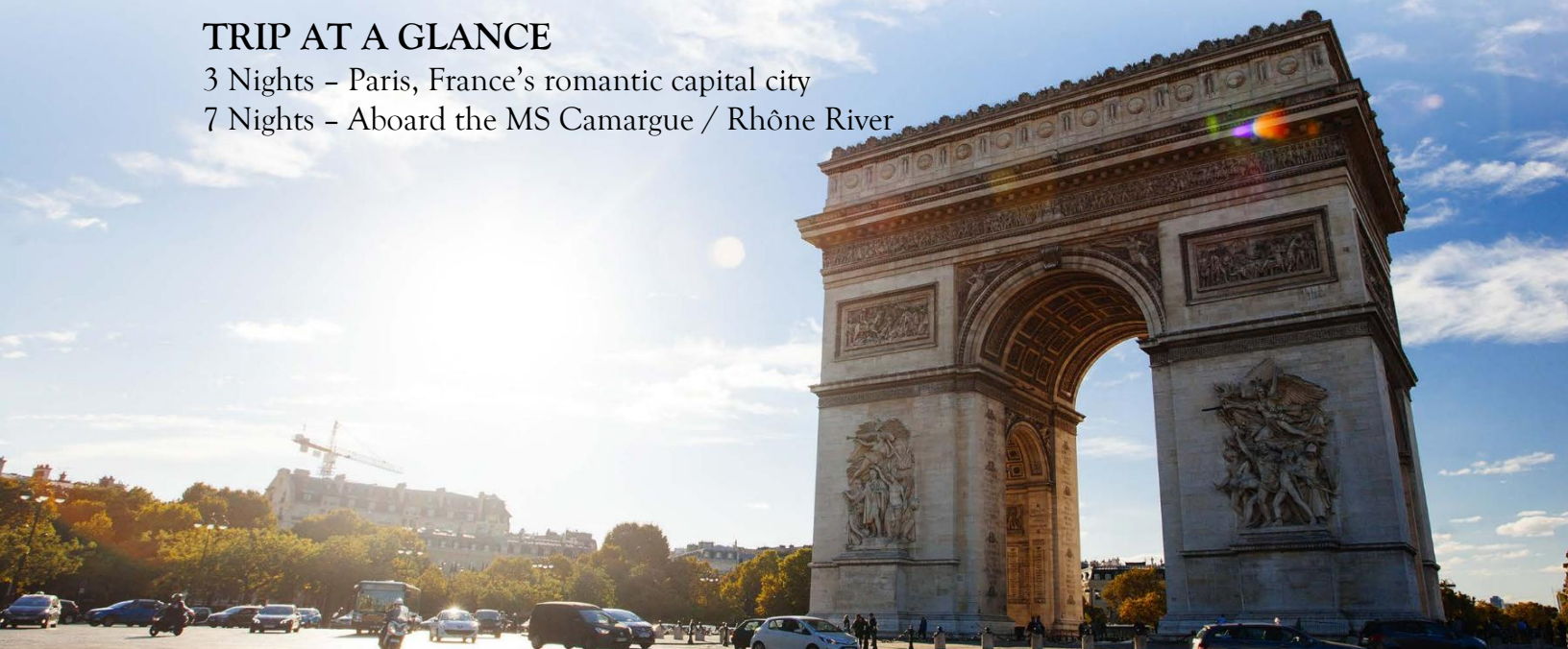

YOUR JOURNEY BEGINS!

DAY 0 | APRIL 7, 2027: DEPART USA

Depart U.S. independently for France no later than April 7 to arrive by April 8. We suggest that you arrive one extra day early to adjust to the time zone and rest. You can never have enough time in Paris!

DAY 1 | APRIL 8: IN THE CITY OF LIGHT, PARIS

Bienvenue à Paris! Enjoy a delicious welcome feast in Paris and orientation at a local restaurant with your KJAZZ hosts, José and Letty, along with your Earthbound Expeditions guides. *Sleep in Paris at the Crowne Plaza Paris République (D)*

DAY 2 | APRIL 9: PARIS – A MOVEABLE FEAST: Paris of the 1930s!

After breakfast, step back into the vibrant Paris of the 1930s, when icons like Josephine Baker, Ernest Hemingway, Louis Armstrong, Pablo Picasso and Salvador Dalí filled the city's cafés with creativity and conversation. Explore the Left Bank and Montmartre, the two neighborhoods that became the heart of Paris's artistic and bohemian life, before enjoying lunch at a traditional Parisian café. The evening is yours to experience the magic of the City of Light at your own pace. *Overnight in Paris (B, L)*

DAY 3 | APRIL 10: DAY IN PARIS

Enjoy a day exploring independently at your own pace. Visit Notre Dame, stroll through the Tuileries Gardens or discover one of the city's great museums. We recommend the Rodin Museum or the magnificent Musée d'Orsay, home to masterpieces by Monet, Renoir and the great impressionist artists. *Overnight in Paris (B)*

DAY 4 | APRIL 11: BURGUNDY, LYON & SAIL SOUTH TO PROVENCE

Journey south by private coach into the heart of Burgundy for an included lunch and intimate wine tasting at a locally owned vineyard. We continue to magnificent Lyon, the country's legendary gastronomic capital, where the elegant MS Camargue awaits. Settle in, meet your fellow travelers for a welcome orientation, and enjoy a superb dinner on board. As evening falls, we sail toward the renowned wine region of Châteauneuf-du-Pape and the city of Avignon. Enjoy your first of many jazz concerts on board this evening. *Overnight aboard the MS Camargue (B, L, D)*

DAY 5 | APRIL 12: ARRIVE IN CHÂTEAUNEUF

This morning, journey into the renowned Rhône Valley for a tasting in the celebrated wine village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, where some of France's finest wines have been produced for centuries. Return to the MS Camargue in time to dine and dance "sous le Pont d'Avignon." Jazz concert this evening. *Overnight aboard the MS Camargue (B, L, D)*

DAY 6 | APRIL 13: ARLES: CITY OF VAN GOGH & PONT DU GARD

Once a great Roman city, Arles is best known today as the home of Vincent van Gogh. It was here that Vincent shared a home with his friend and fellow painter, Paul Gauguin. Enjoy a private tour of Arles' remarkably preserved Roman amphitheater and ancient forum before taking time to wander its lively markets, charming, cobbled lanes and inviting museums.

This afternoon, travel by private coach to the spectacular Pont du Gard. This magnificent 2,000-year-old Roman aqueduct is one of the best-preserved monuments of the ancient world and a masterpiece of engineering, built without mortar from enormous, precisely carved stones. Return to the ship for lunch and continue cruising the Rhône. *Overnight aboard the MS Camargue (B, L, D)*

DAY 7 | APRIL 14: CHARMING VILLAGES OF PROvence

Head into the scenic Provençal countryside to Les Baux de Provence and the delightful town of St. Rémy. Stroll the villages and enjoy a walk around the grounds of the peaceful St. Paul Mausole, a veritable masterpiece of Provençal Romanesque art, built adjacent to the Gallo-Roman site of Glanum. This is the famous asylum where Vincent van Gogh spent time resting and painting. Finally, stop to taste some of the wonderfully aromatic olive oil of this region before heading back to Arles to board the ship. Jazz concert this evening. *Overnight aboard MS Camargue (B, L, D)*

DAY 8 | APRIL 15: A DAY IN AVIGNON

Today we set off to discover the magnificent medieval city of Avignon. This afternoon, explore the magnificent Papal Palace with your local guide, then enjoy free time to wander the city's charming streets and lively squares. Or return to the ship for lunch. Dinner and jazz concert aboard this evening. *Overnight aboard the MS Camargue (B, L, D)*



DAY 9 | APRIL 16: VIVIERS AND TRUFFLE FARMS

When disembarking at Viviers, you have the impression of entering a village where time has stood still. Boasting the oldest cathedral in France still in use, along with impressive examples of Renaissance and 18th-century architecture, Viviers is a lovely stop for pondering the illustrious past. Join an excursion to a local truffle farm, where the adorable working dogs will obligingly demonstrate their truffle-digging skills. Return to the ship for lunch. Enjoy a late afternoon jazz concert. Afterward, enjoy dinner on board. *Overnight aboard the MS Camargue (B, L, D)*

DAY 10 | APRIL 17: DISCOVER LYON

Discover the many charms of Lyon, France's celebrated gastronomic capital. Stroll past the grand opera house and wander through the city's picturesque Old Town. Your guided tour concludes in the early afternoon. Afterward, enjoy lunch on the ship or relax in a charming café. This evening, let us gather one final time for a festive late-afternoon jazz concert followed by a farewell feast.

DAY 11 | APRIL 18: YOUR JOURNEY CONCLUDES IN LYON

Breakfast will be served as usual and transfers to the Lyon airport will be provided for travelers departing today. Reservations and Deposits: A deposit of \$1,000 per person deposit is required to confirm your reservation. You can make a credit card deposit online or by phone. Deposits are refundable, minus a \$250 per person cancellation fee, for 30 days from the processing date or 90 days prior to departure, whichever comes first. Deposits made within 90 days of departure are nonrefundable. A progress payment of \$1,500 per person is due five months before departure. All future payments are also non-refundable, which is why we strongly urge guests to purchase travel insurance.

Not Included: International airline tickets, specialty alcoholic beverages, room service and gratuities for hotel staff, gratuities for ship crew, travel insurance, meals not listed in the brochure, and any activities or items not listed in your itinerary.

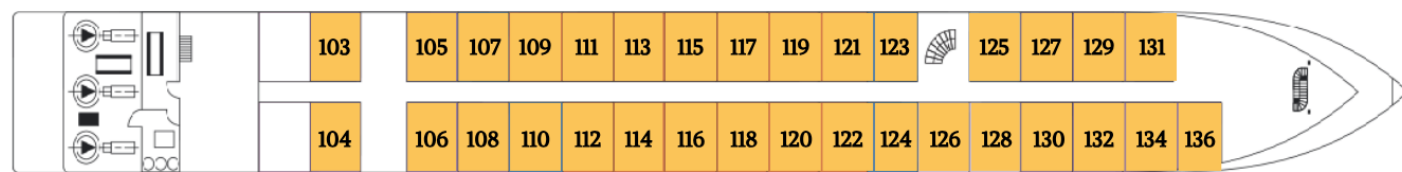
MS CAMARGUE DECK PLAN & PRICING

- Upper Deck - \$7,295 per person
- Suite - \$7,795 per person
- Main Deck - \$6,795 per person

Single Supplement: \$1,700 all cabins (excluding suites). Single availability is limited.

Savings: Discounts apply for all KJAZZ & Earthbound alumni. If you pay your final balance by check, you can save an additional \$100 per person. To qualify there must be a remaining balance of \$3100 per person at time of final payment.

Not Included: Gratuities for ship crew, travel insurance and any items not mentioned in your itinerary. Port taxes, charges, fees are currently \$95 per person and are additional.
