Travel Day: May 16 - Depart the US for Prague

Remember you'll need to depart the US no later than today.

Day 1: May 17 - Arrival Day Prague

Considered by many to be the most beautiful city in Europe, Prague is the city of Kafka and the place Mozart loved best. It was also once home to two legendary Czech composers, Bedřich Smetana and Antonín Dvořák.

The city is also home to three historic opera houses, the Czech Philharmonic, and several chamber orchestras, as well as the historic Estates Theatre. The Estates Theatre is deeply linked with the name of W. A. Mozart. Besides other of his works, it was the venue of world premieres of two Mozart operas: Don Giovanni (on 29 October 1787 - conducted by the composer himself) and La clemenza di Tito (in 1791, to mark the coronation of Leopold II). Enjoy a welcome orientation and dinner before settling in for the night at your hotel. Sleep at the Marriott Hotel in Prague Old Town (D)

Day 2: May 18 - Discover Prague

Our historic walking tour of Prague begins! We will stroll to Prague's most famous landmarks. En route to the Old Town Square, we'll tour the illustrious Estates Opera House. Our journey continues to Prague's stirring, perfectly preserved medieval Jewish quarter. Consisting of five synagogues, a Ceremonial Hall, and a cemetery, Prague's Jewish Museum was created in 1906 to protect precious buildings and treasures for the local Jewish community.

After enjoying a traditional Czech lunch, the afternoon is yours to further explore Prague. Sleep at the Marriott Hotel in Prague Old Town (B, L)

Day 3: May 19 - A full day to Explore Prague

MUSIC After breakfast, we will make our way past Charles University to **EVENT** Charles Bridge. We'll cross the very river that lends its name to Smetana's symphonic Czech masterpiece, the Vltava. Then we'll ascend the hill to one of Europe's most impressive castles: Prague Castle. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the castle consists of a large-scale composition of palaces and ecclesiastical buildings of various architectural styles, from Roman-style buildings from the 10th century to Gothic modifications in the 14th century. Another fabulous classical concert is included this evening. Sleep at the Marriott Hotel in Prague Old Town (B, L)



Day 4: May 20 - Prague: The Chicago Symphony Orchestra!

MUSIC Enjoy a leisurely breakfast this morning; the day is yours to explore and stroll. **EVENT** Suggestions include the Mucha Museum, Kafka Museum, Decorative Arts Museum, and the National Museum, which is the largest museum in the Czech Republic.

Alternatively, dive deeper into the life of Dvořák with a visit to the Antonín Dvořák Museum, established in 1932. Inside, guests can see dozens of letters and household objects Dvořák once used during his lifetime. Perhaps the two most famous objects in this museum's collection are his piano and viola.

Day 5: May 21 - South to Passau, Bavaria - via Bohemia!

After a leisurely morning in Prague, we depart the city for the Bavarian countryside. Driving south, we will visit the small Bohemian town of Český

Krumlov. This town has been writing its story for over 700 years, and each century is uniquely imprinted on its face. A picturesque town boasting a magical atmosphere and inclusion in the UNESCO World Heritage List has developed since then. Enjoy an afternoon in the charming village of Český Krumlov before boarding our 4-star, privately chartered ship, the MS Douce France!

The ship casts off in the late afternoon and takes us through the series of scenic bends along the Danube known as the Schloegener Schlinge. Join your host Fred Child for a welcome concert and dinner. Sleep aboard the MS Douce France (B, D)



Day 6: May 22 - Melk - Vienna

Experience the grandeur of Melk Abbey, an architectural masterpiece nestled in the heart of Austria's stunning landscapes. We then continue our journey to

Vienna, Austria's captivating capital. Prepare for an evening of enchantment with a tour of Vienna by night. Witness the city's iconic landmarks bathed in the warm glow of twilight, a magical experience that promises to leave you spellbound.

Today is a full day exploring Budapest! Experience an exclusive private piano **EVENT** recital at the Franz Liszt Memorial Museum and tour the historic State Opera House. Also included is an excursion to Buda Hill, where you'll have time to soak in the


stunning views. In the late afternoon, you may wish to visit one of the famous bathhouses. Sleep aboard the MS Douce France (B, L, D)
