Day 0, Oct 24, 2022: Depart USA for Dublin

Remember, you'll need to leave the US no later than today.

Day 1, Oct 25: Welcome to Dublin, Capital of Ireland

Arrive in Dublin and transfer to your four-star hotel in the very heart of the city. Rest up and relax before meeting your host Jose Rizo for a welcome to Ireland Feast! *Sleep in the heart of Dublin (D)*

Day 2 & 3, Oct 26 & 27: Explore the Heart of Dublin

A great city for walking, ramble through the city of Joyce's first and most accessible work, *Dubliners*. In addition, we'll visit Oscar Wilde's Trinity College and see the ancient Book of Kells and the Jameson Whiskey Distillery. An outing to a nearby jazz club will be included.

Enjoy three full nights that the Cork Jazz Fest!

Day 4, Oct 28: South to Cork via the Rock of Cashel and Kilkenny

After a hearty Irish breakfast we head south to the Rock of Cashel in County Tipperary. Legend associates the Rock of Cashel with St. Patrick.

After our visit we travel on to the place many consider to be the loveliest large town in Ireland: Kilkenny on the River Nore. Towering over the town is the 12th century stronghold of the Butler family, Kilkenny Castle. Enjoy lunch in Kilkenny and then we drive south to Cork to catch the Jazz Fest! *Sleep in Cork at the famous Metropole Hotel (B, L)*

Days 5 & 6, Oct 29 & 30: The Cork Jazz Festival & More!

We'll spend the next two days attending the Guinness Cork Jazz Fest and exploring this fascinating region. Excursions include the Old English Market and the town of Cobh. The Cobh Heritage Centre has fascinating exhibits on the Irish famine and mass emigration from Ireland. Cobh was the final port of call of the Titanic before it sank and the MS Lusitania also sank just off the coast. The Titanic Experience Cobh and the Lusitania Memorial are also worth a visit. *Sleep in Cork at the Metropole Hotel (B & L daily)*

THE METROPOLE HOTEL: YOUR HOME IN CORK!

The famous Festival Club at the Metropole Hotel is celebrating its 43rd edition and will once again play host to a top range of diverse artists and music on several stages throughout the Jazz Festival weekend. Fans of swing, funk, groove, blues and Dixieland will be well catered for, with an exciting mix of Irish and international acts. Patrons may move from stage to stage to enjoy the atmosphere and excitement of the Festival Club in this special celebratory year.



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Discover the castles of Ireland

Day 7, Nov 1: North to Killarney and Dingle via Blarney Castle

After breakfast we head out for Killarney National Park. Weather permitting, we'll hop on a horse drawn carriage (jaunting car) and tour Killarney National Park. For centuries the Killarney Valley has been recognized as Ireland's most beautiful destination - being aptly titled as "Heaven's Reflex". It inspired Poet Laureate Alfred Austin to write "If mountain, wood and water harmoniously blent, constitute the most perfect and adequate loveliness that nature presents, it surely must be owned, that it has, all the world over, no superior." Prepare to be amazed by the incredible beauty, rich history, fascinating legends and wonderful culture of this special place. *Sleep in Killarney (B, D)*

Day 8, Nov 2: The Spectacular Dingle Peninsula

Our travels will take us past the sites for the films *Ryan's Daughter* and *Far and Away* on the way to the magnificent Blasket Center, an impressive heritage center where the ancient language and culture are celebrated. We continue our journey to the 1200-year-old Gallarus Oratory, an early Christian stone church with a uniquely cobbled stone roof that is watertight to this day! Along the way, taking a step back in history, we see a few of the ancient Beehive Huts. *Sleep in Killarney (B, L)*



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Explore the Cliffs of Moher!

Day 9, Nov 3: Killarney to Galway via the Castle of Bunratty

We depart this morning for Galway, via County Limerick. Our first stop will be the 13th century Bunratty Castle. Then enjoy a pint and lunch at Durty Nelly's pub, built in 1620. After, we make our way to the charming town of Galway. Enjoy a tea, a pint or a bit of shopping. Check into our centrally-located hotel and enjoy drinks and dinner with friends this evening. *Sleep in Galway (B, L, D)*

Day 10: The Awe-Inspiring Cliffs of Moher and the Burren

Today we visit two of Ireland's greatest geologic wonders: The Cliffs of Moher and The Burren. The 600-foot-high Cliffs of Moher are spectacular, especially when viewed from the water. Weather-permitting we'll board a large boat and cruise the Atlantic for a breathtaking view of the cliffs.

After an independent lunch we are off to the Burren, a unique and extraordinary *karst* (formed from limestone) landscape, one of the largest in Europe. Everywhere are traces of megalithic tombs, ringforts, holy wells and stone rows. We also make a visit to the seaside village of Doolin and the high crosses of Kilnefora before returning to Galway. Enjoy a farewell feast with your KJAZZ host and guide. *Sleep in Galway (B, D)*

Day 11, Nov. 4: West to Dublin / Return home

After a leisurely breakfast we return to Dublin (please note that it is a 2-hour drive back to Dublin). We ask that you also book an afternoon flight home "if" you plan on joining the group transfer shuttle. For those staying on in Ireland, the driver and coach will bring you into the city center. Bon Voyage!



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ABOUT YOUR KJAZZ HOST JOSE RIZO

Jose Rizo was born in Guadalajara, Mexico and raised in Oxnard, California. He played trumpet in high school, but it was not until he was a student at U.C. Santa Barbara that he developed his passion for jazz. In the late 70s, Jose was the founder of “Radio Chicano”, a student and community broadcasting organization based on the Santa Barbara campus at KCSB, where he served as program director for two years. Rizo began hosting “Jazz on the Latin Side” on KLON (now KJazz) in early 1990. He was intricately involved on KLON’s “Latin Jazz Club Caravans” and served as a member of the Grammy’s Screening committee for Latin Jazz. He has been the artistic director of the Luckman Fine Arts Latin Jazz Concert Series and involved in the “Central Avenue Jazz Festival” since its inception.
