TOUR THE HISTORIC PARIS PALAIS OPERA GARNIER




Enjoy a special tour of the Palais Opera Garnier! A 19th-century architectural masterpiece, the Palais Garnier Opera House, built by Charles Garnier and opened in 1875, is the 13th opera house in Paris since the introduction of French opera by Louis XIV in 1669. Napoleon III commissioned it as part of the renovation works in the capital carried out under his command by Baron Haussmann.

The ceiling in the main auditorium, painted by Marc Chagall, took a year to successfully complete. This imposing work stands out for its luminous colors and myriad details including winged characters, quintessential Parisian buildings and monuments like the Arc de Triomphe, and musical instruments. The especially keen-eyed may find Chagall himself or André Malraux, who commissioned this monumental fresco.













YOUR CLASSICAL JOURNEY BEGINS

DAY 0 APRIL 10, 2024: DEPART NORTH AMERICA FOR THE SOUTH OF FRANCE

In order to arrive in time, you'll need to depart North America no later than April 10. You may also wish to arrive a few days early and relax and explore the beautiful coastal city of Nice.

DAY 1 APRIL 11: ARRIVE IN NICE OR MARSEILLE

Passengers are welcome to board our ship, the *MS Van Gogh* at 6 p.m. After comfortably settling into your cabins, we'll introduce our crew at a welcome cocktail. We'll enjoy dinner on board. The rest of the evening is yours to do as you please. Our ship will cruise towards Port-Saint-Louis. (D)

DAY 2 APRIL 12: PORT-SAINT-LOUIS / PONT DU GARD / VAN GOGH'S ARLES



Join the excursion to the spectacular 2,000 year old aqueduct of the Pont du Gard. Considered one of the best preserved antiquities in Europe, it is a stunning feat of Roman engineering. Built without mortar,

the massive stones were perfectly carved and placed and have staunchly survived for centuries.

We'll also tour a town that is an example of Provence at its quintessential best; Arles is filled with Roman ruins still used today and shops displaying traditional Provençal fabrics, herbes de Provence, honey, lavender and soap. The Musée Réattu contains many of Picasso's sketches and there are year-round photography expositions and





galleries including the Van Gogh Foundation, which feature rotating exhibits of contemporary works. Enjoy a late walking tour of Arles' highlights and return on board for dinner. Sleep on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 3 APRIL 13: ST REMY / VAN GOGH / OLIVE OIL TASTING

Head into the scenic Provençal countryside to the delightful town of St Rémy. Stroll the villages, and enjoy a walk around the grounds of the peaceful St Paul Mausole, a veritable masterpiece of Provençal Romanesque art, built in the neighborhood of the Gallo-Roman site of Glanum. This is the famous asylum where Vincent Van Gogh spent time resting and painting. Finally, stop to taste some of the wonderfully aromatic olive oil of this region before heading back to Arles to board the ship. Sleep on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 APRIL 14: AVIGNON / THE PAPAL PALACE

MUSIC EVENT Enjoy the lively atmosphere of the medieval walled city of Avignon where we will have a walking tour of the city and the Popes' Palace.

Stay in town for lunch in a local café or walk back to the ship to dine. We'll have dinner onboard and dance on the deck "sous le Pont d'Avignon." Classical concert this evening. Sleep on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 APRIL 15: VIVIERS / TRUFFLE FARMS

When arriving in Viviers, you have the impression of entering a village where time has stood still. Join an excursion to an enchanting village and some local truffle farms, where the adorable working dogs will obligingly demonstrate their truffle-digging skills. Sleep on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 APRIL 16: EXPLORE LYON



Spend a day exploring this spellbinding city. Tour the opera house, the Roman theater and explore the city's charming neighborhoods.

Winding their way through buildings, courtyards, and up and down staircases, Lyon's secret covered passageways, or "traboules," are an ideal way of visiting the city's hidden and colorful past. Every traboule is different though. Each has a unique pastel color, a particular curve or spiral staircase, vaulted ceilings or Renaissance arches. Classical concert this evening. Sleep on board. (B,L,D)

You'll be treated to a walking tour of Paris today and an included lunch, after which we'll tour the spectacular Opera Garnier. (B,L)

DAY 9 APRIL 19: A DAY IN PARIS: IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE LOST GENERATION

Enjoy some free time in Paris today to shop and visit any museums that tickle your fancy. (Be sure and make reservations ahead of time!) We'll also offer a fun cooking demonstration at the famous Cordon Bleu. (Space will be limited). We'll gather tonight for a farewell dinner and toast to our "tres beau voyage!" (B,D)

DAY 10 APRIL 20: DEPART PARIS FOR THE USA

Your journey culminates after breakfast today. Have extra time? Why not spend a few additional nights in Paris and visit Monet's springtime gardens in Giverny. Paris is a feast for the senses! *Bon Voyage!*

YOUR CLASSICAL PERFORMANCE TODAY HOME: MS VAN GOGH

Completely renovated in 2018, the *MS Van Gogh* has been redesigned and refitted according to the new standards of the company and offers larger, bright and comfortable spaces. In terms of decoration, the colour combination of gray blue and orange creates a lot of style and elegance. In a nod to the artist whose name it takes, the ship showcases some of his famous paintings, including those from the Sunflowers series. The patterns of the fabrics as well as the dressing of the bar follow the techniques developed by Van Gogh: impressionism and pointillism.

The two main common areas are located on the upper deck. At the front, the lounge / bar and at the back, the restaurant where all meals will be served during the cruise. The 20 cabins on the upper deck have French balconies and the 34 cabins on the main deck have windows. On the sun deck, an ideal place to relax and admire the landscapes, passengers can enjoy comfortable sun loungers, as well as a large shaded area.


MS VAN GOGH DECK PLAN & PRICING
