Your Classical Journey Begins...

Day 0, May 25: Depart for Berlin no later than May 25, 2026.

Day 1: Tuesday, May 26 - Guten Morgen! Arrive in Berlin

Berlin, once devastated and divided, has spent the last two decades rebuilding into a cultural powerhouse. With thriving orchestras, newly reopened museums, and the revitalized Unter den Linden boulevard, the city is now Europe's cultural hub. **Enjoy a welcome dinner and orientation** with your Sarasota Concert Association hosts and Earthbound Expeditions guide. *Sleep in Berlin (B, D)*

Day 2: Wednesday, May 27 - Discover Berlin

Join an expert guide for a **full-day exploration of Berlin's** most significant historical landmarks. Our journey begins with a visit to the Holocaust Memorial, followed by the Bebelplatz, infamous for the Nazi book burnings on May 10, 1933. Delve deeper into 20th-century history as we visit a preserved section of the Berlin Wall and Checkpoint Charlie. **Enjoy a special lunch inside the iconic Reichstag building and a cruise on the Spree River to view Berlin's historic architecture from the water.** *Sleep in Berlin (B, L)*

Day 3: Thursday, May 28 - Berlin's Great Museums

Berlin is home to some of the world's finest art and archaeology collections, making it a must-visit for culture enthusiasts. This morning, we will explore the renowned **Pergamon Museum**, which houses ancient treasures like the Ishtar Gate and the Pergamon Altar. **A traditional multi-course lunch is included.** Then, the afternoon is yours to further explore the treasures of Berlin. This evening, attend the **Berlin Philharmonic with conductor Semyon Bychkov** leading the orchestra in Shostakovich's Symphony No. 5 and **pianist Vikingur Olafsson** performing Beethoven's "Emperor" Piano Concerto No. 5. *Sleep in Berlin (B, L)*

Day 4: Friday, May 29 - Historic Potsdam and an Evening with Bach in Leipzig

This morning, we depart Berlin for Leipzig. Crossing the legendary “Bridge of Spies” we first visit Potsdam Schloss Cecilienhof, where Truman, Churchill, and Stalin shaped the future of post-war Europe.

After an included **lunch**, we continue to Leipzig, long celebrated as a center of music and culture. The city has inspired great composers including Bach, Beethoven, Mendelssohn, Robert and Clara Schumann, Wagner, and Mahler. This evening, experience a **concert featuring the 90-member St. Thomas Boy Choir** at St. Thomas Church, where Johann Sebastian Bach once served as cantor. *Sleep in Leipzig (B, L)*

Spend three magical nights in Leipzig

Day 5: Saturday, May 30 - In Bach's Footsteps

After breakfast, meet your local guide for a glimpse into the world of Bach. Leipzig is where Johann Sebastian Bach spent 27 of his most productive years. A new **Bach Museum** recently opened and it's been brilliantly done. Bach worked at St. Thomas Church as a cantor and his remains are buried below the altar. Enjoy excerpts from **Bach's B-minor Mass at St. Thomas Church** this evening. *Sleep in Leipzig (B, L)*

Day 6: Sunday, May 31 - A Day with Mendelssohn and Robert and Clara Schumann

Begin the day with a special visit to the former home of Felix Mendelssohn, now a museum devoted to his life, music, and legacy. Enjoy a guided tour and brief lecture, followed by a performance featuring works by **M. Pilati, L. Berio, F. Busoni, Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy, and Fanny Hensel**, performed by acclaimed violinist and violist Michael Barenboim, son of conductor **Daniel Barenboim**.

After a shared lunch, continue to the Robert and Clara Schumann House for an in-depth look at their remarkable lives and artistic partnership, **concluding with a private piano recital honoring their music**. Overnight in Leipzig (B, L).

Enjoy a cruise on the Elbe River

Day 7: Monday, June 1 - Leipzig to Dresden

This morning, travel east to Dresden, often called “the Florence of the North.” Journey along the scenic Elbe River, passing picturesque villages and medieval castles. En route, stop in Meissen, world-renowned for its fine porcelain. Enjoy a guided tour of the **Porcelain Museum** and a **multi-course lunch**.

Continue to Dresden, your home for the next three nights. Once the capital of Saxony and a crossroads of European trade, Dresden has long been a center of art and music and was home to Handel, Bach, and Wagner. After checking into your centrally located hotel, enjoy a leisurely **walking tour of the historic Old Town**, where the city’s rich cultural legacy comes to life. *Sleep in Dresden (B, L)*

Day 8: Tuesday, June 2 - A Day of Art and Music in Dresden

This morning, in the company of a local art expert, immerse yourself in Dresden’s world of masterpieces. Within the graceful **Zwinger Palace**, the Old Masters Gallery unveils centuries of brilliance—Raphael’s luminous *Sistine Madonna*, Giorgione’s serene *Sleeping Venus*, and works by Titian, Vermeer, Dürer, Rembrandt, and Rubens. Each gallery reveals the soul of Europe’s artistic past, preserved in this Baroque jewel of a city.

Savor a refined **luncheon** before a leisurely afternoon—perhaps to wander along the Elbe, linger in a café, or explore Dresden’s elegant boulevards and quiet courtyards. This evening you’ll attend a concert by the **Rotterdam Philharmonic Orchestra**, with conductor **Lahav Shani** leading the orchestra as pianist **Martha Argerich** performs Schumann’s Piano Concerto, followed by Brahms’s Symphony No. 2.

Sleep in Dresden (B, L)

Day 9: Wednesday, June 3 - A Day of Leisure in Dresden

Enjoy a relaxed morning in beautiful Dresden, visiting a favorite museum, or simply savoring a coffee in one of the city’s elegant cafés. After an independent lunch, **embark on a scenic afternoon river cruise**, taking in Dresden’s skyline and the gentle countryside beyond. This evening, experience a **recital by International Chopin Piano Competition winner Seong-Jin Cho**, performing works by Bach, Schumann and Chopin, a perfect finale to your time in this city of art and harmony. *Sleep in Dresden (B)*

Day 10: Thursday, June 4 - Return to Berlin

After a leisurely morning we return to Berlin by private coach. Enjoy a farewell lunch together in a nearby **Saxon winery** before returning to Berlin for the evening.

Day 11: Friday, June 5 - Return home with a lifetime of memories!

Your journey concludes after breakfast. Airport transfers are included if departing today. Happy and Safe travels! (B)

If you have extra time and love classical music, consider extending your journey to the city that Mozart loved best! Prague is just a 4.5 hour train or bus ride from Berlin.
