About Dining and Meals in Central Europe - Lunch is King!

Central European cuisine is delicious, but often hearty, so we've chosen to include most meals at lunchtime. This leaves evenings lighter and more relaxed, so you can fully enjoy the wonderful classical concerts that are at the heart of our journey

Day 0: Depart for Historic Vienna

You'll need to depart your home city today for enchanting Vienna no later than May 8, 2027. We highly recommend arriving a day or two early so that you may rest and relax before the tour begins.

Day 1: Sunday, May 9 – Welcome to Vienna: Home of Mozart, Mahler, Strauss and Beethoven!

Upon arrival, transfer to your centrally located hotel and settle in before meeting your All Classical hosts, Kristina Becker and Fred Child, and your Earthbound Expeditions guide for a welcome orientation and festive Welcome to Vienna feast! *Overnight in Vienna (D)*

Day 2: Monday, May 10 – In the Footsteps of Mozart and Beethoven

Discover Vienna's rich musical heritage on a guided morning walk through its elegant streets. With a knowledgeable local expert, learn why 18th-century Vienna became the musical capital of Europe. Visit Mozart's residence, where he composed *The Marriage of Figaro*.

Following a traditional Viennese lunch, tour the Beethoven Pasqualati House, where he wrote his Fourth, Fifth, and Seventh Symphonies. This evening, enjoy a special Mozart chamber music concert. *Overnight in Vienna (B, L)*





Tour the renowned historic Musikverein

Day 3: Tuesday, May 11 – Vienna's Museum of Fine Arts, the Musikverein and an evening concert

Begin the day at Vienna's magnificent Museum of Fine Arts, one of the world's premier art museums. Admire masterpieces by Bruegel, Rubens, Rembrandt, Vermeer, Dürer, Raphael, Titian, and Velázquez, along with a special exhibition celebrating the life and music of Gustav Mahler.

Following lunch at a traditional Viennese café, enjoy a guided tour of the legendary Musikverein, home of the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra.

This evening, attend a memorable performance by one of Vienna's celebrated musical institutions, such as the, Vienna State Opera, Volksoper, or Wiener Konzerthaus. TBA
Overnight in Vienna (B, L)

Day 4: Wednesday, May 12 – Belvedere Palace and the University of Vienna Botanical Gardens: This morning, visit magnificent Belvedere Palace, home to one of Europe's finest art collections, including masterpieces by Gustav Klimt, Monet, and Manet. After exploring the museum, stroll through the beautifully landscaped Baroque gardens.

This evening, attend a memorable performance by one of Vienna's celebrated musical institutions. TBA

Day 5: Thursday, May 13 – Through the Wachau Valley to Mozart's Salzburg

This morning, bid Auf Wiedersehen to Vienna as we journey west to Mozart's birthplace, Salzburg. Travel through the breathtaking **Wachau Valley**, one of Europe's most picturesque river landscapes, to magnificent **Melk Abbey**, a masterpiece of Baroque architecture. Explore its grand halls, remarkable art collections, and magnificent library of medieval manuscripts. If we're fortunate, we may even hear the hauntingly beautiful Gregorian chants of the resident monks. After lunch and a guided tour of the abbey, we continue west, passing **Ansfelden**, the birthplace of composer **Anton Bruckner**, before arriving in charming Salzburg. *Overnight in Salzburg (B, L)*

Day 6: Friday, May 14 – Mozart, Salzburg & Europe's Oldest Restaurant

Known as the "Florence of the North," Salzburg enchants with its Baroque beauty, winding lanes, and magnificent Alpine setting.

With a private local guide, stroll through the historic heart of the city to Mozart's birthplace, passing several beloved *Sound of Music* landmarks along the way. Then enjoy an included lunch at St. Peter Stiftskulinarium, founded in 803 and considered Europe's oldest restaurant.

This afternoon is yours to explore, perhaps riding the funicular to Hohensalzburg Fortress for spectacular views over the city. This evening, join your hosts for a special concert in Salzburg. *Overnight in Salzburg (B, L)*

Day 7: Saturday, May 15 – Journey to Classical Prague

After breakfast, travel through the beautiful Bohemian countryside to Prague, the legendary “City of a Hundred Spires.” Few cities possess such a rich classical music heritage. Prague was home to great Czech composers Bedřich Smetana and Antonín Dvořák, while Mozart adored the city and its enthusiastic audiences. Settle in for a three-night stay and celebrate your arrival with a traditional Czech welcome dinner. An optional classical concert may be available this evening. *Overnight in Prague (B, D)*

Day 8: Sunday, May 16 – Old Town, Jewish Quarter and Prague Spring Music Festival

Discover the timeless beauty of Prague on a guided walking tour through its medieval heart. In Old Town Square, admire the monument to Jan Hus, the elegant Church of St. Nicholas, and the magnificent Old Town Hall, home to the world-famous medieval astronomical clock.

Continue to Prague's historic Jewish Quarter, where you'll visit the Old New Synagogue, Europe's oldest active synagogue, and the remarkable Old Jewish Cemetery, one of the continent's oldest and most moving historic sites.

Enjoy free time this afternoon to stroll Prague's charming streets, browse inviting shops, or relax at a café before the evening's musical highlight. Tonight, experience a world-class performance at the renowned **Prague Spring Music Festival**, one of Europe's premier celebrations of classical music. *Overnight in Prague (B, L)*

Day 9: Monday, May 17 – Anton Dvořák Museum and Music, Music, Music!

This morning we visit the fascinating Anton Dvořák Museum (Villa Amerika). Here we will learn about the life of one of the Czech Republic's most distinguished composers. Our musical journey continues as we make our way to The Vyšehrad Cemetery. This is one of the most significant cemeteries in Prague. Over 600 famous people are buried here—writers, scientists, poets, artists, composers, actors, doctors, politicians, and others. At the cemetery's eastern end, you'll find the monumental tomb Slavín, where the nation's most famous personages are laid to rest such as Dvořák and Smetana.

A traditional delicious Czech farewell lunch is included.

This evening, meet your guide and hosts to attend a special classical concert presented by the **Prague Spring Music Festival**. *Overnight in Prague (B, L)*

Day 10: Tuesday, May 18 – Return home with a lifetime of happy memories!

Your All Classical journey concludes after breakfast this morning. You may wish to extend your stay and enjoy a few more glorious days in Prague, taking in more of the city and its celebrated music festival!

Vienna is one of the world's great musical capitals, and our time here brings its extraordinary legacy to life. We'll explore places associated with Mozart and Beethoven and attend an intimate concert in the beautiful Baroque Sala Terrena, where Mozart performed during his early days in Vienna. We are also planning a carefully selected major performance at one of Vienna's celebrated venues, with possibilities including the magnificent Musikverein, Konzerthaus, Vienna State Opera, or Volksoper. Performances are hand-selected to showcase the very best of musical Vienna.

Salzburg: What to Expect

Few cities celebrate Mozart quite like Salzburg! Music fills historic churches, palace halls, intimate salons, and grand concert venues. Expect a special musical evening selected from Salzburg's finest performances, along with visits to the places where Mozart was born, lived, and created.

Prague Spring International Music Festival

Our journey culminates with at least two performances at the legendary Prague Spring International Music Festival, one of Europe's great celebrations of classical music. The festival traditionally opens on May 12 with Smetana's stirring *Má vlast* (*My Country*), a beloved Czech musical tradition. Performances take place in some of Prague's most magnificent halls, including the Art Nouveau Smetana Hall and elegant Rudolfinum. Founded after World War II, Prague Spring has long celebrated music as a force for connection, resilience, and hope—a fitting finale to our musical journey through Central Europe.



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
