These STEAM activities connect culture, science, art, engineering, and social-emotional learning using Surf Soup® Chinese Lunar New Year Adventure.



SCIENCE: Sound, Vibration & Celebration

Goal: Explore how sound and vibration create celebration.

Materials:

Metal bowl or cup

Spoon

Water

Activity:

Fill the bowl with water.

Gently tap the bowl with a spoon.

Watch the ripples move across the water.

Discuss:

How does sound make movement?

Why are loud sounds used during Lunar New Year?

How do celebrations help bring people together?

Connection:

Sound and movement symbolize energy, joy, and new beginnings.



ENGINEERING: Build a Lucky Lantern

Goal: Design a structure that holds light safely.

Materials:

Paper

Tape or glue

String

Battery tea light

Activity:

Design a paper lantern that can hang and hold a light.

Test balance and strength.

Discuss:

What makes a lantern strong?

Why is light important during Lunar New Year?



ART: Zodiac Animal Character Design

Goal: Express identity and personality through art.

Activity:

Choose a Lunar New Year zodiac animal.

Design it as a Surf Soup character.

Add:

Colors

Patterns

A personality trait

Extension:

Write one sentence about what the animal represents.



MATH: Red Envelope Counting & Patterns

Goal: Practice counting, patterns, and simple math.

Materials:

Paper red envelopes (or drawn ones)

Coins or counters

Activity:

Fill envelopes with different amounts.

Compare totals.

Create number patterns.

Discuss:

Why is sharing part of celebration?

How does math help with fairness?



TECH / MEDIA: Traditions Then & Now

Goal: Explore how traditions travel across generations.

Activity:

Draw two panels:

Lunar New Year long ago

Lunar New Year today

Discuss:

What stays the same?

What changes?

Connection:

Stories and traditions travel with families.



STEAM + SEL REFLECTION

Ask students to complete:

“Celebrations help me feel _____.”

“Being together makes me feel _____.”
