Art: Design your own team uniforms inspired by Surf Soup® and your favorite countries.

Practice deep breathing before cheering for your team.

Discuss sportsmanship: how to celebrate, encourage, and include everyone.

Reflection: Which traits of Koa, Surf Soup®, or Prana help you be a better player or friend?

Imagine Holo Holo carrying your soccer ball from country to country

Draw the path and calculate the “distance traveled” (math + imagination)
