Fun Activity: Button Art Storyboards

Materials Needed: Buttons, glue, cardboard, markers

Let children glue buttons on a board to make a scene from the book (e.g., laundry, teddy bear, bowl).

Use markers to add characters or settings around the buttons.

Each child shares their button scene and explains what's happening.

Reading Guide:

Before reading: Have you ever visited a laundromat? What do you imagine?

After reading discussion:


How do small things (like buttons) spark big ideas?
