She will be registering us with the Attorney General's office and the IRS. The Friends of the Library brochure is scheduled to be reviewed as to updating given our new name and status and any Covid impact within the next month.

Laurel Bergren reported that the capital campaign committee has been meeting and setting up the infrastructure for soliciting donations for the building project including a Facebook page exclusively for the project entitled Rehab and Expand 2021. \$16,100 has been collected to date.

Anna Gray reported that an encore performance by Cynthia Clampett will be held through the library's Zoon platform on October 15, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Raffle tickets are now on sale at the library.

Anna Gray initiated a discussion with regard to Friends of the Library's longtime goal of supporting the library's renovation and expansion in terms of donating funds to the building project. A motion was made by Catherine Mahaney and seconded by Alan Rosenberg that The Friends of the Mount Carroll District Library NFP donate \$25,000 to the library for the purpose of expansion. The motion was carried.

A photo op has been scheduled for October 17 at 10:00 a.m. to "kick off" and publicize the building project.
