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Travel Itinerary



A 21-day journey through Kali Puja, Divine Feminine worship, Bengal, Kamakhya, Odisha, Auroville, Pondicherry, food, music, healing, seva, and sacred travel.

This journey is curated as a respectful cultural and devotional pilgrimage into the worship of the Divine Feminine. It is designed for adults travelling from Canada who are seeking more than sightseeing: sacred places, food, culture, music, healing, land, service, and community.

Participants should be comfortable with domestic flights, road transfers, temple crowds, early mornings, changing conditions, and travel across several regions of India.

BENGAL: ARRIVAL, CULTURE AND KALI PUJA

Kolkata, Bolpur and Tarapith

Begin in Kolkata with food, shopping, books, textiles, sweets, local culture, and the atmosphere of Kali Puja season. From there, move into the Bolpur and Birbhum region for a deeper connection to Bengal's sacred landscape, Baul wisdom, music, and devotional traditions.

This section includes the Parvathy Baul ashram / Sanatan Siddhashram context and culminates in Tarapith for Kali Puja, with a respectful focus on Divine Feminine worship, ritual atmosphere, reflection, and spiritual grounding.

SHAKTI PEETHS AND SACRED FEMININE TEMPLES

Kamakhya and Odisha

Travel to Guwahati to visit Maa Kamakhya, one of India's most revered Shakti Peeths and a powerful centre of feminine spiritual tradition. This part of the journey invites participants into a deeper experience of devotion, temple culture, and sacred geography.

Continue to Odisha to explore Chausathi Yogini Temple and Maa Tara Tarini Temple, connecting with ancient sacred feminine symbolism, temple architecture, Shakti worship, contemplation, and local culture.

AUROVILLE, PONDICHERRY AND INTEGRATION

Healing, Sound, Seva and the Sea

After the intensity of temple travel and Kali Puja, arrive in Auroville for rest, healing, sound, food, Matrimandir, seva, and ecological experiences. This section is designed as an integration space for the body, mind, and spirit.

The journey closes in Pondicherry with the beach, local bazaar, cafés, heritage streets, French-Tamil culture, and a shared farewell dinner before travelling onward to Chennai for the return flight.
