Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them. Matthew 7:20

To Please God:

Fearful—causing or apt to cause fear; frightening/feeling fear, dread, apprehension, or solicitude

Unbelieving—not believing, skeptical

Abominable—repugnantly hateful; detestable; loathsome

Murderers—a person who commits a murder (killing a human under conditions covered in the law)

Whoremonger—someone who consorts with whores; a lecher (lascivious) or pander (pimp)

Sorcerers—a person who practices sorcery; black magician; wizard

Idolaters—a worshipper of idols; immoderate admirer; devotee (person greatly devoted to something)

Liars—a person who tells lies

1 Peter 2:1—Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings.

Malice—desire to inflict injury, harm, or suffering on another; evil intent of a person

Guile—insidious (discretely deceitful) cunning in attaining a goal; crafty or artful deception; duplicity (deceitfulness in speech or conduct)

Hypocrisies—pretense of having a virtuous character that one does not really possess

Envy—a feeling of discontent or covetousness with regard to another's advantages, success, possessions

Evil speakings—morally wrong, bad, or wicked speakings (act or utterance)

Revelation 22:12

Romans 1:28-32—And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity, whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful; Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

Unrighteousness—not righteous, not upright or virtuous; wicked; sinful; evil

Fornication—sexual immorality to include premarital sex, adultery, bestiality, oral sex, etc.

Wickedness—the quality or state of being wicked (evil or morally bad in principle or practice; sinful; iniquitous

Covetousness—eagerly desirous; inordinately or wrongly desirous of wealth or possessions; greedy

Maliciousness—intentionally harmful; spiteful; desire to inflict harm or suffering of another; evil intent

Debate—strife; contention; to engage in argument or discussion; to dispute

Deceit—concealment or distortion of the truth for the purpose of misleading; duplicity (deceitfulness in speech or conduct by acting or speaking in two different ways to two different people); fraud; cheating

Malignity—to speak harmful untruths about; speak evil of; slander; defame

Whisperers—a gossip, talebearer, rumor-monger, or the like

Backbiters—to attack the character or reputation (speak unfavorably) of a person who is not present

Haters of God—a person who has an intense dislike for God

Despiteful—malicious (intentionally harmful); spiteful (a malicious, usually petty, desire to harm, annoy, frustrate, or humiliate another person; bitter ill will; malice)

Proud—having or showing a high opinion of one's own dignity, importance, or superiority

Boasters—to speak with exaggeration and excessive pride or vanity, especially about oneself

Inventors of evil things—one who creates or devices a new process that is morally wrong/bad/wicked

Disobedient to parents—neglecting or refusing to comply with or follow the commands of a mother, father, guardian, or protector

Without understanding—absence of comprehension of the Word of God

Covenant breakers—to infringe, ignore, or act contrary to an agreement between two or more persons to do or not do something specified

Without natural affection—absence of the emotion/feeling/sentiment established by nature

Implacable—not to be appeased, mollified (to soften in feeling/temper), or pacified (restore peace)

Unmerciful—merciless (lacking compassion toward an offender); relentless; severe; cruel; lacking pity

Galatians 5:19-21—Now the works of the flesh are manifest, in which are *these*; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Adultery—sexual acts between a married woman and a man that is not her husband or a man and another man's wife

Uncleanness—morally impure; evil; vile

Lasciviousness—inclined to lustfulness; arousing sexual desire; obscene or indecent (language, songs)

Witchcraft—the art or practices of a witch; sorcery; magical influence

Hatred—the feeling of one who hates; extreme aversion or hostility; intense dislike

Variance—instance of varying; departure from cause of action; quarrel

Emulations—to try to equal or excel; imitate with effort to equal or surpass

Wrath—strong, stern, or fierce anger; deeply resentful indignation

Strife—vigorous or bitter conflict, discord, or antagonism (active hostility or opposition)

Seditions—incitement or discontent or rebellion against a government

Hersies—opinion or doctrine at variance with Word of God; maintaining of such opinion/doctrine

Drunkenness—intoxicated; given to drunkenness

Revellings—excessive drinking/partying; boisterous merrymaking or festivity

Ephesians 5:3-7—But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. Be not ye partakers with them.

Filthiness—foul with, characterized by, or having the nature of filth; disgustingly/completely dirty; vile; vulgar; obscene (offensive to morality or decency)

Foolish talking—speech that is trifling (of very little importance; trivial), insignificant; lacking forethought or caution; showing lack of sense

Jesting—a joke or witty remark; witticism; bantering remark; sarcasm; to say what is not true for diversion (divert the mind from serious concerns)

Unclean person—human being who is morally impure; evil; vile

Vain words—ineffective or unproductive language; speech incapable of producing a result; powerless and pointless talking
