# Old Mill Village Pool Rules

SEASON: Saturday of Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day

HOURS: Open daily 12 noon to 8:00pm (May/August/September school days – opens at 4:00pm)

There is a required rest period the last 15 minutes of each hour. This time is reserved for ADULT SWIM. Only children aged 6 or younger may accompany their parent(s) into the main pool or baby pool during this time.

ADMITTANCE: Entry is allowed with current pin or guest pass only.

- Pool pins are available for Old Mill Village residents ONLY. There is a one time fee of \$5.00 per pin; each person in the household must have a pin. The pin must be retagged at the beginning of each pool season to validate it for the new year.
  Attaching the pin to your beach towel or a beach bag you bring with your regularly is recommended. Failure to present your pin will result in refusal of admittance.
- 2. ALL GUESTS MUST SIGN IN & OUT EACH TIME AT THE ENTRANCE GATE.
- 3. Guest passes are available to Old Mill Village residents to be used by their non-residential pool guests. Passes must be signed by a current adult OMV resident to be valid. Guest passes can not be used by residents on the DO NOT SWIM list. Passes are available online at oldmillvillage.net or from the pool managers and lifeguards.

APPAREL: Only regular swimwear is permitted in the pool (no cutoffs, undergarments, street clothes, etc.)

### CONDUCT:

#### **BABY POOL:**

- 1. This pool is for the use of children age 5 or younger and their adult(s).
- 2. Children must be accompanied at all times in the pool area.
- 3. No food, beverages, or glass is allowed in the baby pool area.
- 4. Small inflatable toys as well as other baby pool toys are allowed.
- 5. Children who are not potty trained must wear swimmer diapers to prevent pool contamination. This is mandatory and monitored.
- 6. No towels may be hung on the baby pool fence as they obstruct lifeguard views.

### MAIN POOL:

- 1. No children under the age of 12 are permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by someone age 14 or older who can also swim.
- 2. No one is permitted in the deep end unless they are able to pass a swimming test administered by the lifeguards.

3. No actions that are <u>inappropriate</u> or that put swimmers in danger will be tolerated. These include but are not limited to the following:

NO RUNNING NO PROFANITY

NO PUSHING NO MALICIOUS BEHAVIOR

NO DUNKING NO DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY

NO SPITTING NO THROWING

NO HORSEPLAY NO DISRESPECT TOWARDS ANY INDIVIDUAL

- 4. No glass is permitted inside the main pool fence. This includes diving masks.
- 5. No alcoholic beverages are permitted inside the main pool fence.
- 6. There is NO SMOKING within the main pool fence or in the clubhouse. Any individual smoking on the Pool/Clubhouse grounds who's smoke is affecting pool guests, may be asked to move to a further location.
- 7. Inflatable toys are allowed in the SHALLOW END ONLY if the pool is not crowded. This will be determined by the lifeguards on duty.
- 8. Please dispose of all trash in our trash containers that have been provided on the property. Soiled diapers must be tightly wrapped before being deposited into the trash containers.
- 9. No one with any signs of infection will be permitted into either pool. This includes but is not limited to: diarrhea, skin infection, etc.
- 10. Please keep our grassy areas clean and good condition! Clean up after yourself and guests and be conscience of others around you.

## **DIVING AREA:**

- 1. Only one diver is permitted on the board at a time. Please wait until the diver is in the water before stepping onto the board.
- 2. NO BOUNCING ON THE DIVING BOARD.
- 3. Wait until the diver in the water has moved to the side of the pool before diving.
- 4. For safety reasons there is NO SIDEWAYS OR BACKWARDS DIVING, NO COMPETITIVE DIVING AND NO DIVING IN THE SHALLOW END.

## **CONSEQUENCES:**

Safety is always our main concern. Failure to follow the above rules as well as any instructions from our lifeguards or pool managers will result in immediate dismissal from the pool area for the day. If it is a child, they will need to be accompanied by an adult to regain entrance on future days. If an adult continues to disregard the rules or instructions of our lifeguards or pool managers, the guest will be put on the DO NOT SWIM list for the remainder of the season. Old Mill Village Lifeguards and Pool Managers have the right to dismiss any pool guest as they deem necessary.

Old Mill Village residents are responsible for any damages caused by themselves or their guests to the pool, pool area, or clubhouse. Any resident may petition the Board for a reinstatement hearing. All rules and penalties are invoked to protect you, your family, and friends.

We all must help to assure ALL residents and their guests can enjoy the facility. Thank you for your cooperation and we hope you have a wonderful experience at the Old Mill Village HOA Pool!
