CANADA NURSE REGULATORY PROGRAM

Overview

The Canada Nurse Regulatory Program is a foundational program that supports nurses whose aim is to work and live in Canada. The program will take nurses through different stages, including English evaluation, WES accreditation, NNAS assessment report, province license, and immigration support.

This program timeline is around 9–18 months; each stage will have its own processing time. Nurses, however, can seek expedited provinces such as New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, and Newfoundland and Labrador.

The Canada Nurse Regulatory Program Breakdown

The program takes numerous stages; please note that fees are not expected to be **paid all at once**, and you must understand that **you can go at your own pace**.


Pay your program Fee

Clients interested in joining the program must pay a program fee of **300CAD/35,400JMD**. This program fee covers IELTS Exam booking, World Education Service Degree/Diploma assistance and Province Licensing assistance (National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS).

You can start the Canada Nurse Regulatory Program Application by paying your program fee using the following options:

Ensure to keep a copy of your receipt, as you will be required to upload the proof of payment. You can submit The Canada Nurse Regulatory Program Application here after fees have been paid: <u>Canada Nurse</u> <u>Regulatory Program Application Form</u>





Once you have submitted your application form, you will be sent a IELTS booking invite which will require you to book your IELTS or have an agent book the Exam on your behalf. Please note this exam cost **\$40,000JMD**.



Educational Credential Assessment (ECA for IRCC Canada): This will be required for your Express Entry, PNP and PR application. The cost is **\$160USD/25,600JMD**.

4 National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS)

The **National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS)** is a Canadian Not-forprofit organization that offers a streamlined process for Internationally Registered Nurse (IEN). Registered Nurse and Practical Nurse will have the option to select which province they would like to practice in. Please see the following options:

- 1. NNAS's new Expedited Province: New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and Newfoundland & Labrador. The Expedited Service of **\$750CAD/88,500JMD** for a single RN and LPN application, result after submission is 5 business days. (Quickest Migration Route in being licensed, PNP Nurse Stream in these provinces and seeking jobs).
- 2. **NNAS' Regular Application:** This can be any province of your choice, please ensure to conduct research to see which caters to your personal preference and which offers a PNP Nurse Stream for example Ontario, British Columbia or Alberta. The NNAS' Regular Application fee is **\$650USD/104,000JMD**.



All nurses will be required to sit the NCLEX Exam. Testing locations are Canada and USA. If nurses do not hold a Canada or USA visitor visa, we do provide support with the visitor visa application. The NCLEX Exam Fee: **USA 200USD & Canada 360CAD**.

6 Provincial License

Once you have received your assessment report from National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS), you will be required to submit an application for license via that regulator board. Note, some regulator broad my ask to sit an NCLEX RN/PN exam. Based on being different province, we are unable to place the province license amount. **Ranges from 150CAD to 300CAD**.



All clients resume will be tailored to Canadian Resume Standards with guidance provided for where to submit job applications with interview coaching at an **additional cost of \$5,000JMD** to have you prepared for your role.

Provincial Nomination

- 1. Clients can express interest in a Provincial Nomination (PNP) Stream or create a profile in Express Entry. Both pathways can lead to permanent Residency in Canada. The cost to submit an application to PNP is \$750USD (Note: This does not include the Nomination Application Fee paid to the province as this varies based on selected province).
- 2. Clients have the option to submit multiple expressions of interest to multiple PNP streams, but you are only allowed to apply for one provincial nomination. The additional cost is \$300 USD. (Note: you can create a PNP Nurse Steam Express of Interest Profile on your own). If you are only doing a Provincial Nomination Application with the RCIC Partner, the fee is \$450 USD.

Express Entry & Permanent Residency

Express Entry & Permanent Residency: All clients will be required to submit an Express Entry Profile once you have received your IELTS & WES results. Please note that the following prices include the Express Entry Profile Creation and Permanent Residency Application:

- Principal applicant: \$ 1500 USD (Note that you do have the option to create an Express Entry Profile on your own). If you are only doing the Permanent Residency Application with the RCIC Partner the cost is \$1200USD.
- 2. Family: Spouse is **\$500USD**, per Child is **\$250USD**.

Settlement Funds Requirement

NB. You don't need to show that you have enough money to support yourself and your family if you're authorized to work in Canada and have a <u>valid job offer</u>.

Please note the above Express Entry & Permanent Residency Fees is the service cost and does not include the processing Fees Required For Canadian Permanent Resident Application.

- 1. **LMIA Work Permit:** This means you are now able to seek jobs as you have acquired your license.
- 2. Express Entry: Creating a profile for interest in Permanent Residency.
- 3. **PNP Nurse Stream:** Creating profile for interest to work and live in that province.
