# Welcome to ROAR

The inaugural ROAR Study newsletter welcomes everyone within the neurovascular community who wants to learn more about the work we are undertaking. Through this national collaborative research the ROAR study will answer many of the questions we have around the natural history of unruptured intra-cranial aneurysms. Through these quarterly newsletters we will keep you appraised with updates on recruitment, funding and data acquisition.

# NIHR grant success

The ROAR team are delighted to announce the award of an NIHR RfPB grant from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2022 – 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024 which includes the study in the NIHR portfolio. This covers all costs of data collection and analysis.

We are therefore able to provide members full support for set-up and data collection (eg R+D set up costs and research nurse time to perform data collection). Please contact us to discuss how we can support your unit's activities.

### Data so far

Seven units have finished data collection and have identified 5,307 patients with 7,065 aneurysms. These are expected to have 59,730 years of follow up. By comparison the PHASES meta-analysis included 8,382 patients with 10,272 aneurysms and 29,166 years of follow up.

We are therefore making excellent progress towards our overall target of 20,000 aneurysms to be able confidently describe all potential predictors of rupture.

# Protocol paper

We are finalising a manuscript to publish the ROAR protocol. We intend to include all active data collectors as collaborators on this paper and will be in contact about this soon.

# **Training**

We are still able to offer data collection training via Zoom to any units whose study members have not yet completed it.
