God knows that not all of us are good singers and that not all of us can sing on key. Perhaps that is why he has the psalmist say, õMake a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing.ö (Psalm 100:1-2).

Those who, like me, are tone deaf, may make more noise than song. That is still welcome. God said, õMake a joyful noise . . .ö Moreover, it occurs to me that if I do not sing the hymns as best I can, I am holding back a part of myself from the worship of God. God never said, õJust worship me with the very best parts of you.ö Instead, God wants us to worship him with all that we are and all that we have.
