# Pastor John's Jottings . . .

The August 2018 issue of Dynamic Preaching has a story in it about the Sydney Swans rugby team. For years the Sydney Swans had a dismal, losing record. The home games were played to a mostly empty stadium. Then they got a new coach and some new young players and suddenly they were winning. They were a powerhouse. Soon the stadium was full of joyful fans, a ticket to a home game was very hard to come by.



At one of these games, the camera was panning across the joyfully cheering crowd. There was one man standing up and holding a sign that said, õI was here when nobody else was!ö

When the team is winning, everybody wants to be part of the action. But when the team is losing, most people leave. Still there are always a few die-hard fans who are in it for the long haul. Those fans will support their team no matter what.

Jesus knew about fair weather friends. In John chapter 6, Jesus begins to share the difficult details of his ministry. And people start to drift away. Jesus had been drawing huge crowds wherever he went. Now though, even some of his closest followers seemed to be losing enthusiasm. John writes, õFrom this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him . . .ö

This must have been very difficult for Jesus. He asks his twelve disciples, õYou do not want to leave too, do you?ö

Then Peter answers him, õLord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.ö I love that. The disciples were in it for the long haul. They were not distracted by the glitter and false promises of the world. They had their eye on the One that counted, the one who had the words of eternal life.

As we move into summer, there will be many things that compete for our time. Following Jesus and making time for worship takes much more effort. Jesus looks at each of us and asks, õYou do not want to leave too, do you?ö
