

Summary/Decline of the Christian Church

0+AD Original Church, at Jerusalem/Doctrinally Sound.

*Pelagianism ("Free Will" theory introduced by Pelagius, in 4th century). (1).

500 AD

1000 AD

1500 AD Reformation Period - Calvinism (3) vs.

Arminianism. (2). Biblical Literal Gospel vs.

Free Will Gospel "Concept".

2000+AD Age of Apostasy - Abandonment of Christian faith, cause, and principles by "professed" (not actual) believers.

(1). Pelagius - 4th Century British monk, who introduced the false doctrine of a required "free will" decision, in cooperation with divine grace. He also denied the doctrine of predestination.

(2). Arminius - Reformation era promoter of "free will" theology, as Pelagius advocated.

(3). Calvin - Protestant reformer. Biblical literal gospel defender (per the "apostles' tradition").
