0+AD <u>Original Church</u>, at Jerusalem/DoctrinallySound. \*Pelagianism ("Free Will" theory introduced by Pelagius, in 4thcentury). (1).

1500 AD <u>Reformation Period</u> - Calvinism (3) vs.

Arminianism. (2). Biblical Literal Gospel vs.

Free Will Gospel "Concept".

2000+AD <u>Age of Apostasy</u> - Abandonment of Christian faith, cause, and principles by "professed" (not actual) believers.

(1). <u>Pelagius</u> - 4th Century British monk, who introduced the false doctrine of a required "free will" decision, in cooperation with <u>divine grace</u>. He also denied the doctrine of <u>predestination</u>.

(2). <u>Arminius</u> - Reformation era promoter of "free will" theology, as Pelagius advocated.

(3). <u>Calvin</u> - Protestant reformer. Biblical <u>literal</u> gospel defender (per the "apostles' tradition").
