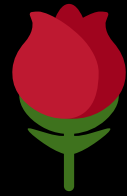


AMALIE

Living in her kombi, that's where she wrote her latest singles: 'Good Luck Black Cat' and 'So Please'. Amalie worked with (platinum award-winning producer) Garrett Kato on production.
