

2022 YOUTH PRIDE CHORUS HEALTH PROTOCOLS

- Participation in the 2022 Youth Pride Chorus of South Florida (YPCSF) is for fully vaccinated students
 only. All members and staff of the Gay Men's Chorus of South Florida (GMCSF) are fully vaccinated.
 Fully vaccinated means at least 2 weeks after the second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or the
 single dose of the Johnson & Johnson's vaccine.
- Rehearsals will be held at Sunshine Cathedral with seating spaced for social distancing.
- Masks are required when entering and exiting the building and any time when you are not in your seat singing. Breaks will be held outdoors whenever possible. If you need to use the restroom, quietly leave your seat, wearing your mask.
- If you have any of the following symptoms suggestive of COVID-19, you should not attend rehearsal and immediately notify your section leader and/or program staff: Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting or diarrhea.
- If in the last 7 days, you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, you should not attend rehearsals and notify your section leader and/or program staff.
- By attending rehearsals and the performance, you are saying to your fellow chorus members that you
 have been fully vaccinated, you do not have symptoms, and you have not been recently exposed to
 COVID-19.
- As CDC and local guidelines change, the GMCSF may change procedures for in-person events at any time. This includes requirements about social distancing and masks.
- IF YOU ARE FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF ANY OF THESE PRINCIPLES AND/OR POLICIES, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PROGRAM.
