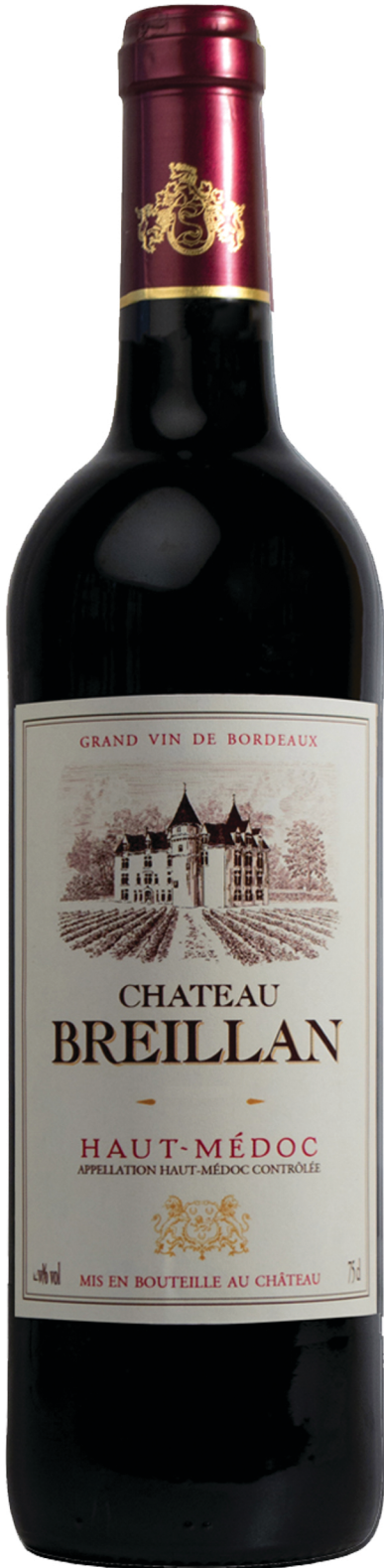


CHATEAU BREILLAN HAUT-MEDOC BORDEAUX



APPELLATION

Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France

VARIETALS

90% Merlot, and 10% Cabernet Franc

VINEYARDS

Breillan is situated in Blanquefort on the outskirts of Bordeaux. Situated to the east of the village, the chateau is surrounded by woodland and vines. A wonderful 42 hectares that is composed of gravel and calcareous clay soil.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine offers a beautiful dark color, garnet red, bordered with purple hues. Its bouquet is expressed on fruity notes of blackcurrant, raspberry and redcurrant with an animal and spicy touch. On the palate, it presents a very good balance, with a tannic structure mastered and coated by a material that is both opulent and melted which gives it a very charming finish.
