WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Deep, dark red in color. The complex nose feature herbs and mature red berries like cherry and gooseberries followed by gentle tobacco notes. The tannins are round, firm and with great texture on the palate, accompanied by some sweet walnut notes in the after taste, leading to a long, pleasing finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Serve it with slow-cooked Beef like Short Ribs or a T-bone, or Rosemary Lamb Shank.
