APPELLATION

Castillon Cotes de Bordeaux, Bordeaux, France

VARIETALS

70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 10% Cabernet Franc

VINEYARDS

The vines of Chateau German were planted during the 18th century on the terrace of Castillonais, adjoining the land of Saint-Emilion and produce a red wine typical of the appellation Castillon Cotes de Bordeaux.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Intense color, ruby reflections and shiny. Black fruits, warm cedar, hints of black licorice, mocha notes on the nose. Palate is medium bodied, with a punch of dark fruit laced with hints of vanilla and accented by pepper, spice and mocha notes.

FOOD PAIRING

Roasted Red Meats, Pasta with Red Sauce, Pulled Pork, Charcuterie Boards, and Cheeses such as: Camembert, Roquefort and Brie.
