

Gentle Spirit Alpaca Farm

The Chyla Cowl

Requirements:

100 yards alpaca/merino bulky weight yarn
US Size 15 needles (10mm) and cable stitch holder.
Gauge is not important as long as you like the look of the pattern.

Instructions:

Cast on 14 stitches.

Work in 12 row pattern below until scarf measures approximately 54" or desired length, ending after Row 12. Bind off loosely. Block to shape. Use a tapestry needle to sew the ends together after cowl is blocked. Slipping the first stitch of each row will keep the scarf from rolling on the edges.

Pattern:

Pattern is worked over 6 rows

Row 1: Slip 1, K1, P2, K6, P2, K2

Row 2 and all even rows: Slip1 P1, K2, P6, K12, P2

Row 3: Slip 1, K1, P2, K6, P2, K2

Row 5: Slip 1, K1, P2, CB3, CF2, P2, K1

Row 7: Slip 1, K1, P2, CB3, CF2, P2, K1

Row 9: Slip 1, K1, P2, K6, P2, K2

Row 11: Slip 1, K1, P2, K6, P2, K2

CB2 - slip 3 stitches on a cable needle, hold in the back, knit 3 stitches then knit the 3 stitches on the cable needle.
