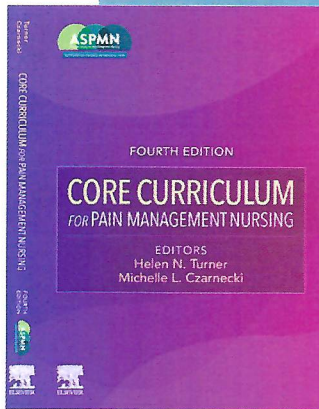

Certification

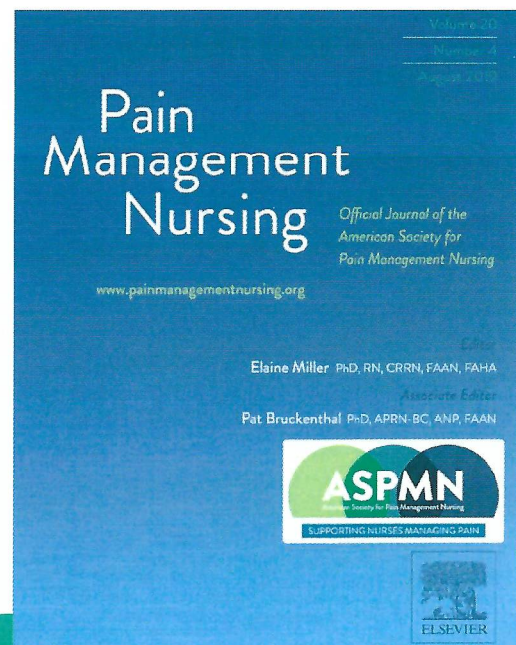
- ASPMN and ANCC offered the first national certification in pain management nursing in 2005.

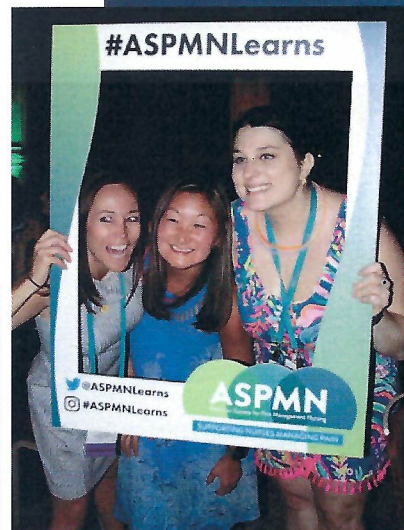
