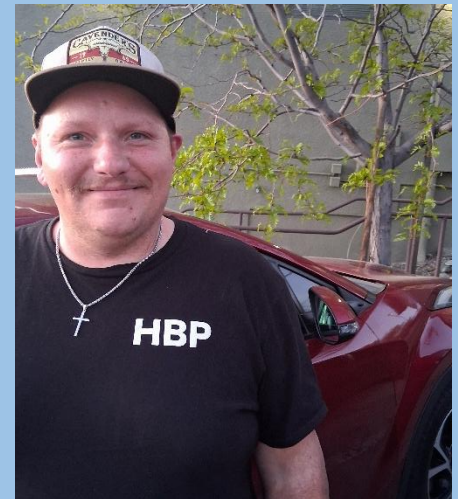
“After more than ten years of homelessness and several overdose scares, I made the decision to turn my life around. However, I soon realized that starting over was an impossible journey to take on alone.
