## Cry Out

Psalm 34:6 (ESV)

This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him and saved him out of all his troubles.

Have you ever come to the end of yourself?

Praise God! You are in good company and in for a blessing.

There are no doubt, times and seasons in every believers life where spiritually speaking they have come to the end of their selves. In this season, it seems as if we were completely desolate and afflicted in every way both inside and out and in our hearts and minds and in our circumstances as well. In this place of destitution, we feel as if nothing were for us but only against us. We know in our minds that God is for us but we cannot reconcile ourselves from within the reality in experience that He is for us. We long for a taste of the Lord and His grace and attention toward us. We feel the pressure rise from within that we cannot go another moment without seeing something, anything.

It is here we are to cry out or call out vigorously to the Lord and with great intention and passion.

*'This poor man cried,'* do you hear and feel the desperation and longing for the faintest touch from the Lord here?

'*and the LORD heard*.' Oh, we know the Lord always hears the prayers of the righteous made right by the blood of Jesus Christ. But hear what David is saying, '*and the LORD heard*.' This is to say that the Lord presently and actively heard. Thank you, Jesus!

Psalm 22:24 (ESV)

Just let God Himself be your salvation in every trial and tribulation in this life. He promises to hear and save in the best possible way.
