HARPER FAMILY RECONNECTION REUNION MEETING NOTES for: Tuesday July 2, 2024

1. We identified reunion details so far:

- a. 35th Anniversary, 1-day event, August 17, 2024, at Brookside Nature Center, Wheaton, MD where the historic Harper Cabin is located.
- b. Theme: Building on Our Heritage, Tradition & Legacy
- c. August 17th is John Thomas Harper's birthday. He was born in 1837, 187 years ago. He is the identified resident of the Harper Cabin.
- d. Anticipated Attendance: 50 60

 - We'll ask family members to RSVP so that we can properly prepare for attendees.
- 2. **Report on Harper Cabin Site Visit (Faith Harper-MD)**: Faith reported that the site visit went very well. There have been some improvements made at The Cabin and Center since our last visit 10 years ago. Inside The Cabin trinkets and knickknacks have been minimized making it more sustainable. Outside, the walkway path has been improved and benches have been added.
 - Faith was able to visualize/identify where our reunion activities would take place within the Center. She also discussed parking and identified the need to make it accessible for senior family members.
- 3. **Report on Harper Cabin Heritage Day (Faith & Beverly-MD)**: Faith and Beverly served as Harper Family Ambassadors during the Maryland Montgomery County Parks 25th Annual Heritage Days weekend, which showcased The Harper Cabin at Brookside on Sunday, June 30th. Their presence was well received as most of the area cabins have no living descendants identified and/or actively taking part in events and activities. Cabin attendees were delighted to speak with descendants of John Thomas Harper and to hear of his upcoming birthday.
 - Shirl Spicer, countywide museum manager for the Maryland-National Capital Park & Planning Commission, Department of Parks, Montgomery County, was also in attendance and spoke with Faith and Beverly. Ms. Spicer has a wealth of historic knowledge regarding The Harper Cabin, and is creating a home school group history program that includes Emancipation. We understand that she may want to include The Harper Cabin in the curriculum and meet/speak with family members. We discussed her meeting with Sylvia and Beverly-PA.

There was also a local band playing who said they grew up with the Harpers and mentioned FedX Billy and ??? The music they were playing was very fitting for the time period and atmosphere. We'll see if we can get them to come to the reunion.

4. Brookside Nature Center - Home of the Harper Cabin: 1400 Glenallan Ave., Wheaton, Maryland 20902 We're looking for ideas and suggestions regarding what we can do as a family to build a forever relationship with Brookside especially since it's the home of The Harper Cabin, and because our family member, John Thomas Harper has been identified to represent a historic era in our country's history. The following ideas have been suggested. Family members are asked to forward any ideas they have to Sylvia.

- a. Coordinate communications between Brookside and family members re: upcoming events and activities, especially those involving the Harper Cabin.
- b. Secure family members to become family representatives/ambassadors.
- 5. **Report on Reunion T-Shirt Contest (Cathy) :** There were a couple designs sent in which Cathy is working with a printer to format visually on a shirt for showing to family for a vote. The process took longer than expected. However, we anticipate being able to provide the designs to family members the week of 7/8/24.

- **7. Report on Bus from Philly**: Beverly-PA will provide information regarding, cost, date/time, and location for sending to family members.

8. Reunion Itinerary:

- a. **Honoring Our Past:** We'll identify family members who have passed beginning 2020 through this year by the reading of their names and the ringing of a bell, followed by an all-encompassing prayer to pay tribute to all others.
