I know this may seem long but read it so you'll know what's happening on our 35th Anniversary Reconnection Reunion weekend. Thank you.

The Harper Family Reconnection Reunion is on Saturday August 17, 2024, 10:30 am - 3:30 pm.

It is the 35th Anniversary of our first reunion held in 1989.

It is a 1-day event at Brookside Nature Center, Wheaton, MD where the historic Harper Cabin is located and identified as the home of John Thomas Harper. John Thomas Harper's birthday is also on August 17th. He was born in 1837, 187 years ago.

This will not be a typical Harper Family Reunion.

It is the first gathering of family members since covid (5 years ago). The theme of the gathering is: *Building on Our Heritage, Tradition & Legacy*. It is an opportunity for us to reconnect, examine where we are as a family, update our family history, consider where we go from here and ultimately, identify "who's got next", because time waits on no man, woman or child.

Ms. Shirl Spicer has invited family members to visit the Josiah Henson Museum and Park during the weekend. Josiah Henson is said to be the inspiration for 'Uncle Tom's Cabin'. The Museum is located on the grounds of the former plantation where Henson was enslaved prior to self-emancipating to Canada. The site includes a visitor center, historic house with an attached log kitchen dating to 1850, and a 4-acre landscaped park with accessible walking paths. Anyone wishing to visit should see Ms. Spicer on Saturday for free admission tickets.
