FORMAT

Corporate team event — 3 doubles matches per team match: round robin pool play.

Each team shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 players: 2 men and 2 women; maximum of 6 players. For each team, at least 50% of the players must be current employees of the Corporate entrant team, while up to 50% can be Associates. New for 2025, each individual team match must include at least 1 Corporate employee member; 2 Associates (non-employees) can never play together. To maintain competitive fairness, only amateurs are eligible to play; semi-professional and professional players with a 4.5 and higher rating are ineligible to play. Sandbagger players can get disqualified without warning.

Limited to the first 14 teams to register and pay. Open to adults 18 years and older. Participants are limited to 1 participating team.

USAPA rules will be observed. Each individual match will consist of 1 game, first to 11 points or 8 minute time limit. All players must use USAPA approved pickleball paddles. The Home team will provide the timer for each team match. 4 outdoor courts will be used.

- 1 team match = 3 individual matches that include:
 - Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles & Mixed Doubles (Male + Female).
- All matches must have at least 1 employee playing.
- Each team is guaranteed at least 4 team matches.
- All teams will qualify for the Finals Round (Championship or Consolation Bracket).

Zero Tolerance for Unsportsmanlike Behavior:

All participants and their supporters are expected to to uphold integrity, demonstrate respect, and practice fair play, including honest line calls, at all times. Unsportsmanlike behavior such as trash talking, cheating, non-player interference and or disrespectful conduct will not be tolerated.
