RE: Independent Medical Examination (IME)

Dear Client:

The Insurance Company's attorneys have scheduled your IME. Please bring a photo ID with you.

It is imperative that you attend this appointment. Please be advised that there is a "no-show fee" which may be applied if you do not keep the scheduled appointment or when cancellation of the appointment is made less than one week in advance. Please let us know right away if you are unable to keep this appointment.

This examination is very important to your case, and I am writing to provide you some guidance on how you should conduct yourself.

It is important to remember that this is an examination by a physician who is being paid by the defense. You should fully explain to him the extent of your injuries, the pain and suffering that you continue to go through and the restrictions the injuries have caused on your work, your family life and your social activities. Much of what you say to the doctor will be placed in a report that the doctor will use if and when the doctor may eventually testify against you at the hearing.

Please pay close attention to the doctor's questions and your answers and also to the various parts of the physical examination. When you return home after the examination, please sit down the same day while things are fresh in your mind and answer the brief questionnaire which we have enclosed for your convenience. It is extremely important that you make your answers as full and complete as possible and that you write out in detail everything you can remember that was said by the doctor and by you and everything that was done during the examination. We have enclosed a stamped, self-addressed envelope for your convenience so that you can return the questionnaire to our office after the independent medical examination.
