A MESSAGE FROM THE GRAND KNIGHT

Those Communist Nuns

As we drift toward socialism and beyond, I am reminded of my 9th grade parochial school teacher, Sister Mary Margret. As one of the good Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary she gave us a great education along with an ample dose of discipline. demonstrated by my slightly enlarged knuckles. It was 1963 at St Michael the Archangel School in Miami, Florida and we were wrapping up the school year. In Civics class we had learned about the common forms of government: Laissez-Faire, Monarchy, Democracy, Socialism and Communism. One student asked Sister Mary Margret "Sister what do you think is the best form of government?" The nun thought for a moment and then replied, "Why I think Communism is the best form of government.

We all gasped silently and immediately looked at each other whispering "WHAT! What is she trying to feed us?" Living 90 miles from the coast of Cuba we had a better awareness of Communism than most youngsters our age and that statement really caught us off guard. She went on to explain that, for example, her convent of nuns who teach at our school all took a vow of poverty and live a Communist lifestyle, to wit: "From each according to their ability and to each according to their need. And it works very very well. But there is one problem, one very big problem.

She then went on to explain that "For Communism to work...you have to have a bunch of nuns running it!"

I never forgot that lesson.
