Peace be with you! I joined the Knights shortly after my 18th birthday. I was at college, my +Dad called one night and said, I need you home next Tuesday night, and wear a coat & tie. We learned early in life, don't ever ask "Why", just say "OK, what time". I am the 3rd son, but the 1st to join the Knights; as my 4 younger brothers reached 18. +Dad made the same call to them I'm sure. By 1983 these "5 brothers" were 3rd Degree brothers of the Knights of Columbus. Five years later +Mom received her heavenly reward; I had moved from PA to NY to NC to VA by then. The next year +Pop called and said, "I need you home 22 October, come early to get measured for a tux". Yes sir. On October 22, 1989 our +Dad watched as 5 of his sons were exemplified into the 4th Degree of the Knights of Columbus, the Patriotic degree. I have to say that I believe it was one of his proudest moments; in +Mom's place he was escorted by his two daughters. +Pop joined +Mom in 1995, knowing that one more of his sons, the 2nd eldest, was a brother Knight. In 2020, his eldest son, shortly before passing, became a Knight. On 25 November, our +Parents' 77th wedding anniversary, the remaining 3rd Degree brother, will be exemplified into the 4th Degree. I know +Mom & +Dad are smiling!


