Let us Pray for our country and for the conversion of evil into a return to faith and love for one another. God Bless America.





Tractor pulls, farm animal exhibits, amusement rides, farm equipment displays; then there were exhibits: school art & science projects, pies, flowers (+Mom was a blue ribbon winner for her roses), canning items, arts & crafts and needle works; there's a parade and a Fair Queen, in fact a good friend of mine was Fair Queen our senior year (and almost prom date, I could've been Royalty!). 
