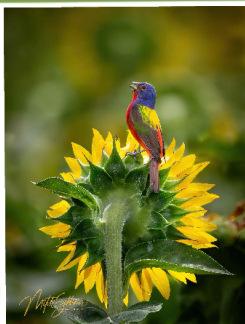
Do YOU know GOLF BASICS ?
