RULES AND REGULATIONS

We would like to make this an enjoyable experience for all campers, so we ask that you abide by the following rules. By registering to stay at Paul Ogle Riverfront Park Campground you and your registered guests are hereby agreeing to abide by all rules and regulations of Paul Ogle Riverfront Park.

General Rules

Permits – Each campsite will be issued a permit upon payment for site. Please display this permit on or in your camper where it is visible from the outside.

Speed Limit – is 5 MPH in the *entire campground*. Please keep our children and other guests safe!

Quiet Time – is 12:00am to 6:00am. Radios and TVs should not be heard beyond your site during this time and children should be with parents at their campsite. Please be considerate of your neighbors.

Campfires – must be within the fire rings or your grills. NEVER leave a fire unattended and fires must be extinguished before turning in for the night or leaving the campground. Wood only can be burned in the fire rings; NO TRASH is allowed to be burned. Bring your own wood.

Picnic Tables – All sites are provided with one picnic table and one fire ring. **DO NOT** take a table from any other site.

Children – Parents are responsible for children at all times. Please do not leave children unattended.

Pets – are allowed at site. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet immediately. **DO NOT** leave animals unattended.

No Smoking – in any/all buildings and restrooms. This is IN law.

Bicycles – Please have bikes back at site before dark.

Restrooms & Shower House – Please remove all personal items from the restrooms and shower house. Any articles left in the restrooms or shower house will be disposed of when restroom is cleaned. Restrooms and shower house are always open except for cleaning.

Trash – Please take all of your trash with you. Dumpsters are not provided. Keep our park clean and do not litter.

Water Usage – Washing of cars and RVS is prohibited. Gray water must be contained and disposed of at Dump Station.

Insurance/Theft – We are not responsible in the case of theft of RV or contents thereof; Nor for any damage caused by natural causes (i.e. tree falling); Nor for spoilage of refrigerator/freezer foods due to loss of electricity. We are also not responsible for loss of money or valuables of any kind. Please enjoy the amenities and be safe.


Alcohol Policy – IN legal drinking age is 21 – this law will be enforced. Alcohol is permitted in Campground area only. Absolutely NO ALCOHOL in other areas of the park.


Golf Cart Policy – Golf carts are allowed in the campground, park area and on the streets of Vevay. Golf carts are not allowed on State Highways, this is Indiana law. No golf carts are allowed to be operated after dark unless they have properly equipped lighting.
