Wonderful to see so many of you at the AAO/OHIG Round Table Discussion at the AAO annual meeting! Thank you for coming and sharing your thoughts and expertise as a group.

Conversations were lively as we discussed several topics:

- I) Trend of a rising number of hospital transfers for ophthalmology consults academic institutions which is being experienced nationally. Discussions about how we can address this challenge in a sustainable and thoughtful way.
- 2) Need for shared dedicated consult triage protocols or guidelines to help navigate this rise in consult volume/transfers.
- 3) Valuable feedback from successful ophthalmic hospitalists who currently work in private practice.
- 4) More academic centers have acquired OCT machines for their ER. Discussion regarding the challenges of successful implementation and potential impact on expedited triage.
- 5) Consider ways that OHIG could be potentially involved on AAO council advisory recommendations (CAR) for topics pertaining to hospital-based consults
- 6) Collected input for updating the current published AAO statement on "Inpatient Consults for Ophthalmology" which is due for revision.
