67 Fairway Lane. Homeowner is in arrears on dues in the amount of \$3,700 +/-. He personally deposited a check into the HOA checking account for \$300 with an endorsement stating that the bill has been paid in full. The HOA Attorney, Winzenburg, Leff, Purvis, & Payne LLP, sent a letter advising homeowner that this was not acceptable and that the account was not paid in full. The attorney and LCM Management have advised the HOA to foreclose on the property. The Board, of those present, have agreed to foreclose, but will wait to move until other board members have input.

A Motion was made by Marie Pilkington: I move that the HOA Board proceed with the process of Uncontested Judicial Foreclosure on 67 Fairway Lane, Littleton, CO 80123. In light of an unauthorized deposit to the HOA Checking Account, with an endorsement that stated all fees have been satisfied, per advisement of attorney and LCM it is necessary to recoup unpaid fees. Seconded by Stephanie Ismert and approved by all.

NEW BUSINESS:

Solicitors in the area: They must have a business license issued by the Town before they can go door to door. Police should be called if there is any altercation.
