#### CLARK BRADLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The *Clark Bradley Memorial Scholarship* honors the decades of commitment and impact that Clark Bradley had upon western horsemanship and reining within the IHSA. Bradley was the coach of the University of Findlay Western team for over 30 years. He was an instructor, team coach, competitor and judge. During his tenure at the University of Findlay, the Western team won seven IHSA/American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) Team National Championships and had five AQHA High-Point Open Rider National Champions. In 2001, Bradley was named the AQHA Professional Horseman of the Year. He was inducted into the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Hall of Fame and the All-American Quarter Horse Congress Hall of Fame. This scholarship will be awarded to a deserving IHSA rider competing in the western divisions.
