Be a graduating senior planning to attend a community college or university in the Fall Be of Mexican descent, preferably an immigrant with a farmworker background Have demonstrated financial need

Have a minimum 3.0 GPA and/or show promise and potential for college success (e.g., working to support family, taking college level classes, overcoming hardship, special programs)

To be eligible for the R & M Reyes Family Foundation Scholarship, you must do the following:

- 1. Complete the Application: Student Essay and Information
- 2. Provide Transcript of Grades
- 3. Provide FASFA/CADAA Award Letter
- 4. Attach your Senior Picture or a Recent Photograph
- 5. Submit One Letter of Recommendation from a Teacher or Counselor
