## Southern Gal's Crochet

# **Antler for Max**



Skill level: easy

Materials:

Acrylic yarns worsted weight in Cream and Red

Hook size G (4.00 mm)

Yarn needle

Stitch marker

Pipe cleaner

#### Special instructions:

This pattern is crocheted in the round, unless otherwise stated.

Mark the last stitch of each row with a stitch marker.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

FO = Finish Off

sc = single crochet

st = stitch

Lets begin:

Antler:

In Cream

First piece:

1) sc 6 in magic circle (or first ch of ch 2.)

2 - 23) sc around (6 sts) 22 rnds

FO, leaving tail for weaving



Fold pipe cleaner in half, insert it into the antler, cut off the remaining pipe cleaner sticking out, don't throw it away.

Weave tail through the front loops of all six sts, pull tight, weave excess through antler.





#### Second piece:

1) sc 6 in magic circle (or first ch of ch 2.)

2 - 7) sc around (6 sts) 6 rnds

FO, leaving tail for sewing.

Insert remainder of pipe cleaner and trim excess.

Sew to rnds 7 - 10 of the first piece.

### Strap:

In Red

Ch 51

FO, leaving tail for sewing . weave tails through opposite ends of the loop, use the

remaining tails to wrap around the antler and weave ends.
