



## **Walk Beside Someone**

**Scripture:** *“And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.” 2 Timothy 2:2*

Luke 24:13–35; Hebrews 10:24–25

### **Jesus Is Speaking to You**

As you continue walking with Jesus Christ, you will meet people who need more than a brief conversation.

Some need someone to pray with them.

Some need someone to listen.

Some need encouragement to keep following Jesus.

Some simply need to know they are not walking alone.

Just as Jesus has patiently walked with you, He now invites you to walk beside others. Understand, not to replace Jesus. But to help them walk more closely with Jesus.

### **What Is Jesus Teaching You?**

Throughout Jesus’ ministry, He rarely hurried people.

He walked with them.

He listened to their questions.

He opened the Scriptures.

He corrected with love.

He gave people time to grow.

Discipleship is not about rushing someone toward maturity.

Your calling is to love faithfully, encourage patiently, and continually point people back to Him. The closer you remain to Jesus, the more naturally you will walk with others as He has walked with you.

### **A Lie You May Be Believing**

Maybe you've believed that helping someone means having all the answers.

Or maybe you've felt unqualified because you still have so much to learn yourself.

However, remember this. When Jesus’ disciples followed Him, they were still learning every day.



Jesus did not wait until they understood everything before allowing them to encourage one another.

Don't miss this.

You don't need to know everything.

You simply need to remain faithful to Him.

Walk humbly. Keep learning. Point people to His Word.

Trust Jesus to do the work that only He can do.

### **What Difference Does This Make?**

When you begin walking beside others, ministry becomes deeply personal.

You celebrate with those who rejoice.

You pray with those who are hurting.

You encourage those who are growing weary.

You remind one another of His promises.

You become a living reminder that God's family walks together.

As Jesus Christ becomes your lifestyle, discipleship becomes more than sharing information. It becomes sharing life together while continually looking to Jesus.

### **How Should This Shape the Way You Live?**

As you begin today, ask Me, **"Jesus, is there someone You are inviting me to encourage this week?"**

It may be a new believer. A friend who is struggling. Someone who feels forgotten.

Reach out. Listen before you speak. Pray before you advise. Open the Scriptures together.

Encourage them to spend time with Jesus.

Remain close to Jesus.

The greatest gift you can give another believer is not your wisdom.

It is helping them grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ.

### **A Prayer**

Father, thank You for the people You have placed in my life who have encouraged me to follow Jesus. Help me become that kind of encouragement to others.

Teach me to listen with patience, speak with grace, and love with humility.

Keep me faithful to Your Word and dependent upon Your Holy Spirit.



May every conversation I have gently point people toward Jesus Christ.
