Jesus Is Speaking to You

Understand, you do not have to build your life on uncertainty.
God has spoken. His Word is trustworthy.

What Difference Does This Make?

When your heart is anchored in His truth, fear begins to lose its grip.
Confusion gives way to clarity.

That is not because you wish to win arguments.
Understand, it is because you desire to know Jesus more faithfully.

How Should This Shape the Way You Live?

Before accepting what you hear, bring it to His Word.
Before following a path, ask if it reflects His heart revealed in Scripture.
Before making an important decision, spend time with Him in prayer.

Ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand and faithfully apply His Word.
Remain close to Jesus. The closer you stay to Him, the more His truth will guard your heart and direct your steps.
