On behalf of our small event team and our generous sponsors, we are thrilled to welcome you to the 11<sup>th</sup> edition of the *Perth Kilt Run!* 

This event was first held in 2010 and is the current *Guinness World Record* holder for largest kilted race. As a premiere sporting event for the town, we are thrilled to breathe new life into the *Perth Kilt Run.* This year, we're celebrating the triumphant return of this much-loved event and the start of our second decade of races. We are blown away by the level of interest and support for this race – we sold out all 1,546 spots in less than four months!

To kick off our second decade, we introduced the new Sir Mike Challenge. This event requires participants to run both the Royal Mile and the Classic 5-Mile. Mike Day was a longtime *Perth Kilt Run* participant who ran nearly all previous races and won his age group every year that he ran. A member of the Ottawa Valley Track Club, he was active in local road races well into his 90<sup>th</sup> year. We are proud to honour Mike's memory with this challenge!

At the heart of our event is our volunteers! Without their time, energy, and enthusiasm, we simply couldn't host this event. Thank you for all your efforts to ensure the success of this event!




The Crystal Palace, located on the picturesque Tay Basin, serves as the *Perth Kilt Run* event headquarters, providing a contained race site that accommodates kit pick-up, the start/finish line, and the post-race party. Centrally located, it is within walking distance from nearly anywhere in town.



## **Parking**

There are a number of parking lots in the Town of Perth. We have listed the locations for these lots and the distance to the start line. Parking is also available on town roads, **provided it is not part of the course**. Please ensure you are legally parked and not blocking any driveways, roads, or fire hydrants.



#### Town Parking Lots (Distance to Start)

- P1 Herriott North (250m)
- P2 Herriott South (250m)
- **P3 -** Wilson (400m)
- **P4 -** Arena (500m)
- **P5 -** Conlon Farm (1500m)

#### Private Parking Lots (Distance to Start)

- **P6** Algonquin College(900m)
- P7 Perth Fairgrounds (1100m)
- **P8 -** Shandex(800m)
- **P9 -** Bridge Masters Brewing Co. (300m)











## **Course and Road Closures**

Detours will be in place at 4:30pm with local streets open to local traffic only.

Roads that form the Royal Mile course will close at 4:30pm

Gore Street will be closed from North St. to Harvey St. from **4:30-8:00pm** 

Roads that form the Classic 5-Mile course will **close completely at 6:00pm** and will re-open in four zones. Please see the map below for approximate re-opening times.

# Kit Pick-Up

#### Crystal Palace, 31 Basin Street, Perth Opens at 10:00am

#### Royal Mile and Wee Lads & Lasses:

Kit pick up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 4:30pm.** There will be a designated line for each race.

#### Classic 5-Mile:

Kit pick up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 5:00pm.** There will be three designated lines for this race (A-J, K-R, S-Z)

#### Sir Mike Challenge:

Kit pick up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 4:30pm.**There will be a designated line for Sir Mike Challenge participants. Athletes will pick up **only** their Royal Mile bib before the race. Upon finishing the Royal Mile, participants will proceed to the Crystal Palace to pick up their 5-Mile bib.

#### **Shirts:**

Participants who purchased a shirt can pick it up at the T-shirt table inside the Crystal Palace (beside kit pick up.)

Participants may pick up a bib for a friend/family member, but must show a copy of the confirmation email and a photo of the participant's ID.



## **Royal Mile**

Race Start: 5:00pm

Kit pick-up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 4:30pm.** Pick-up for this race ends 30 minutes before the start of the race.

Kit pick up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 4:30pm.** There will be a designated line for Sir Mike Challenge participants. Athletes will pick up **only** their Royal Mile bib before this race. Upon finishing the Royal Mile, participants will proceed to the Crystal Palace to pick up their 5-Mile bib.


#### Timing:

Race Start: 5:25pm (age 2-4)

5:35pm (age 5-6)

Start Line: 31 Basin Lane, across from Town Hall

#### Race Bib Pick-Up:

Kit pick-up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 4:30pm.** Pick-up for this race ends 30 minutes before the start of the race.

#### Timing:

This race is officially timed by Enfield Timing. Results will be available on Race Roster following the race.


#### **Medals:**

Participants in the Royal Mile will receive a custom medal upon completion of the race. The top 3 male and female finishers in both the adult and youth categories will receive awards.

#### **COURSE LIMIT: 10 minutes for each race**









## Classic 5-Mile

March to the Start: 6:00pm (begins at Colbourne and Drummond Streets)

Race Start: 6:15pm

Start Line: 31 Basin Lane, across from Town Hall

#### Race Bib Pick-Up:

Kit pick-up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 5:00pm.** Pick-up for this race ends 60 minutes before the start of the race. There will be three designated lines for this race (A-J, K-R, S-Z)

#### Sir Mike Challenge Participants:

Challenge participants will pick up their Classic 5-Mile bib in the Crystal Palace immediately following their completion of the Royal Mile. There will be a designated line for Sir Mike Challenge participants.

#### March to the Start:

The March to the Start will be lead by the Kemptville Highland Band and begins at the Mammoth Cheese (Drummond and Colbourne Streets) at 6:00pm. **ALL ATHLETES MUST PARTICIPATE IN THE MARCH.** The march will feature Perth's historic downtown Gore Street and will lead the participants directly to the start line for announcements and the national anthem.

#### Course:

Water stops are located at 1km intervals. There will be electrolyte at 5K. There will also be bagpipers at each kilometre.

#### Timing:

This race is officially timed by Enfield Timing. Results will be available on Race Roster following the race.

#### **Medals and Awards:**

Participants in the Classic 5-Mile will receive a custom medal upon completion of the race. The top 3 male, female, and non-binary finishers in the adult and top male and female finishers in the youth categories will receive awards based on gun time. The top finisher in each 10-year age group will receive an award based on chip time.

**COURSE LIMIT: 90 minutes** 



# Sir Mike Challenge

Race Start: 5:00pm

Start Line: 31 Basin Lane, across from Town Hall

#### Race Bib Pick-Up:

Kit pick up will be held on Saturday, June 21st from **10:00am until 4:30pm.** There will be a designated line for Sir Mike Challenge participants. Athletes will pick up **only** their Royal Mile bib before this race. Upon finishing the Royal Mile, participants will proceed to the Crystal Palace to pick up their 5-Mile bib.

#### Timing:

This race is officially timed by Enfield Timing. Results will be available on Race Roster following the race.

#### **Medals and Awards:**

Participants in the Sir Mike Challenge will receive a custom medal upon completion of each race, plus a bonus ribbon plaque following the Classic 5-Mile. The top male and female finishers will receive an award based on combined Royal Mile and Classic 5-Mile chip times.

COURSE LIMIT: 20 minutes for Royal Mile and 90 minutes for Classic 5-Mile





## Support on the Course

Participant safety is our top priority! There are a number of measures in place to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable race experience.

Please dial 9-1-1 if and notify a race volunteer if athletes notice anyone in distress.

#### **Medical Assistance:**

Lanark County Paramedics will be on-site at the start/finish line and will be prepared for a variety of medical emergencies.

#### **Water Stops:**

Water stops are located every kilometre on the 5-mile course. Electrolyte is available at the 5K mark.

#### First Aid:

Each water stop has someone trained in first aid to assist race participants.

#### **Course Patroller:**

A course patroller will follow behind all athletes to ensure everyone safely completes the course.

#### Course Marshal:

A course marshal will re-open the course by zones as each section of the 5-mile race is completed.













## **Finsh Line Festival**

Congratulations on completing the *Perth Kilt Run*! Please make sure you get your finisher's medal before exiting the finish line area. Water, electrolytes, and a light snack will be available to participants in the Crystal Palace.

Classic 5-Mile participants are also invited to enjoy a beer compliments of Bridge Masters Brewing Company! Each adult bib includes a ticket for your beer. Additional beer can be purchased directly from Bridge Masters during the post-race festival.
