Generally, my sculptures require very little care or maintenance. However, there are some important ways to keep them looking their best.

- At installation, avoid soft or uneven ground, which impact stability and safety.
- Choose a location away from drip lines such as roofs and low areas that collect standing water, which will damage the look of the sculpture and weaken its structure.
- Bolt or anchor the sculpture so it cannot be knocked over.
- The natural rusting process of mild steel will stop at a certain point, resulting in a matte finish, which should cause no harm to the sculpture.
