- The glossy finish of the rusted mild steel can be refreshed once a year by using a brush to apply one or two coats of a 50/50 mixture of FLOOD Penetrol oil-based paint additive and Klean Strip lacquer thinner. Allow it to dry between coats.
- If the glossy mild steel finish scratches or is rubbed off, let that spot rust. It can be resealed when you re-coat the entire sculpture, if necessary.
- Scratches or grime/build-up on the surface of the stainless steel can be removed using scrub pads, sandpaper (120 grit), or stainless steel wire brushes.
