Ricky Wilcox earned 4 varsity letters in wrestling while attending Buena Regional High School. He was a District 32 champion and a 3-time district 32 runner-up. He placed 2nd in Region 8 once, placed 3rd in Region 8 twice, and was a 3-time State Championships qualifier. A student-athlete who was slated to attend West Virginia University, Ricky's promising life was cut short when he was tragically killed in an auto accident on Monday, June 14th, 2004. His legacy lives on in the form of the Ricky Wilcox Memorial Scholarship. Ricky was universally liked and respected by both teammates and opponents, and the scholarship seeks to recognize student athletes who embrace those qualities demonstrated by Ricky. As he did in life, Ricky continues to make an outstanding positive impact on the entire Buena community.

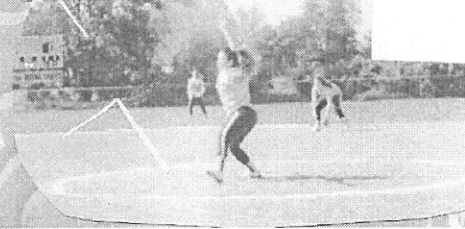


McCarville leads Buena

Gerry Grunwell is the only coach in the history of Buena Regional High School to win a Cape Atlantic League Championship in either girls or boys basketball. That team capped a historic run in 1989 to win the league championship and finished the year with a 23-4 record. As a result, Gerry was named the Philadelphia Inquirer South Jersey Coach of the Year following that season. He was the girls' varsity basketball coach for 12 years and the boys' varsity basketball coach for 5 years. He was also a volunteer assistant basketball coach for 3 years and coached JV baseball for 7 years. Gerry was a social studies teacher at Cleary Middle School for 23 years and at Buena Regional High School for 13 years. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Social Studies from Pennsylvania Military College (now Widener University) in 1969. Gerry retired from teaching in 2006 and likes to spend his time traveling and spending his winters in North Fort Myers, FL. He resides in Swedesboro, NJ with his wife Lauren. Gerry has two sons; Devon and Matthew.

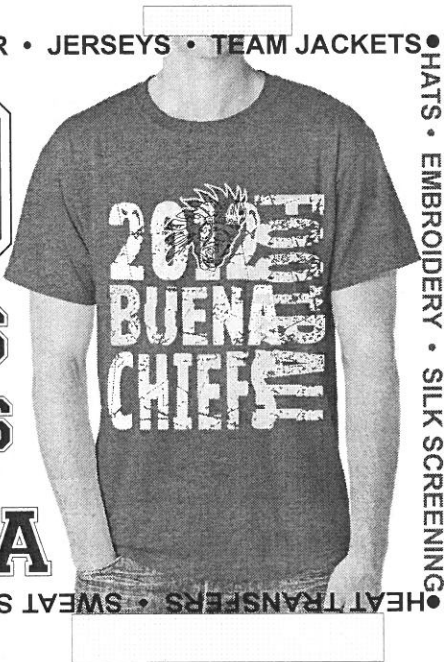

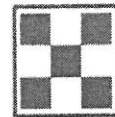

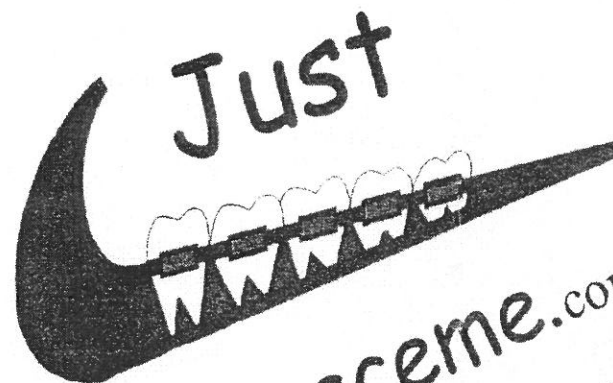
