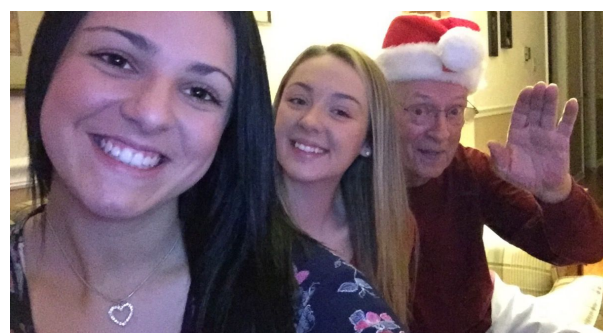

Educator/Coach

Some people view material wealth as the best measures of success in life. Others prefer to judge people by the contributions they have made to the lives of those around them. Based on the latter criterion, Coach Kordos had been the face of track and field and winter track at BRHS. During his tenure, he helped build the Chiefs into one of the most respected programs in the region. Coach K helped nurture a parade of championship caliber athletes during his coaching tenure.

Some people don't realize the difference a coach makes. Steve, a former Marine, had an unmatched drive and inner desire to excel....and his athletes fed off that energy. The inspiration that Coach Kordos had always given to others in the form of quotes and stories as well as animated scenarios was part of Steve's uniqueness as an individual and coach. To quote one of his former athletes, Marcellus Manning, "Coach was a life changing guy who coached from a point of love. It was a relationship we shared."

Today, Coach Kordos has been living at the Heritage Assisted Living Facility in Hammonton as a result of a ruptured aneurysm during the summer of 2005. It ended his career and briefly paralyzed him on the right side of his body. After the stroke, he underwent physical therapy for almost a year and has made great strides in regaining the use of that side of his body. He never regained the use of his right hand nor his ability to use words to speak, but Steve has found his "voice" through his art expression by painting with his left hand!

The Buena boys track and field team had its dream season in 2000. The Chiefs captured the South Jersey Group II and New Jersey Group II championships! Both championships were won by beating Bridgeton, a team that was riding a ten year, 115 dual meet winning streak. Time and time again the boys proved their metal. Steve Cirino won gold in the Group II long jump and 100M. Kile Caldwell captured the 110 hurdles crown and Ed Sul-ton-El was 1st team CAL in the 200M. Rob Kleinow was 1st team CAL in the high jump. The 4x400 relay team of Kile Caldwell, Brandon Caldwell, Eddie Sul-ton-El and Matt Kordos not only won the state relay race but finished the season 7th in the United States. Coach Kordos said, "I couldn't ask any more from those guys. It was a total team effort from kids who absolutely did everything I asked of them the entire year."
