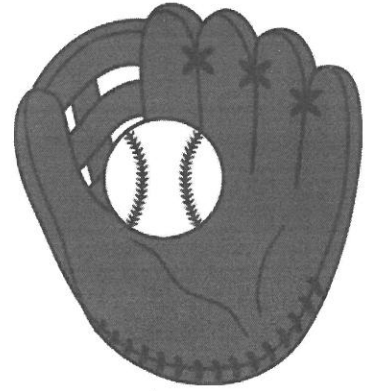

The Lady Chiefs ended the eleven years of St. Joseph's (nine years) and Hammonton High School's (two years) field hockey dominance. A school record five athletes were named to the 1st team Cape Atlantic League National Division. These ladies were Felicia Bianco, Lisa Sikora, Amy Keen, Mary Veneziale and Lindsey Mihaly. The Lady Chiefs also finished as the #12 team in South Jersey as ranked by the writers, coaches and officials throughout South Jersey for the Courier Post. Adding to the championship celebration, Coach Meyrick accomplished her 100th coaching victory. The ladies set a school record 45 goals scored and only allowed 17 goals the entire season.

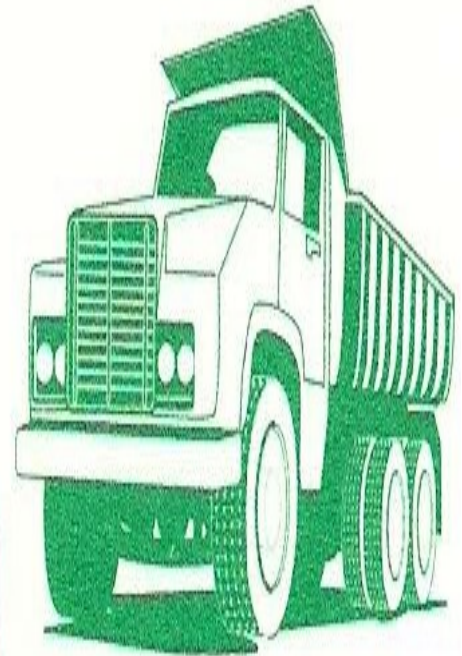

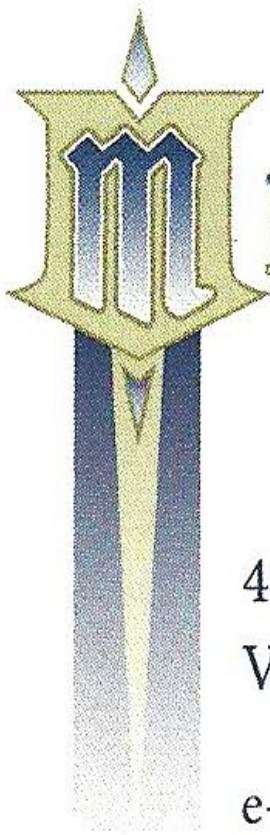
